


Key Activities:

- National Health Training Center, Kathmandu has prepared training package on Case Investigation and Contact Tracing (CICT) of COVID-19 and the training is to be conducted at all the levels (Federal, Provincial and Local level) from 25 June 2020.
- Today 312 people (19 Females and 293 Males) from Dailekh, Mahottari, Rautahat, Sarlahi, Kathmandu, Kailali, Banke, Surkhet, Dhanusha, Saptari and Siraha has been discharged.
- Total number of discharged people till date 2650 (216
 Females and 2434 Males)


Trend of RT-PCR and COVID-19 cases





Key activities

- Preparing Provincial COVID-19 response contingency plan estimating 5000 positive cases. Forecasting of infrastructure, HR and essential commodities has been planned with detail cost estimation
- Bhim Hospital has been identified for expansion of OT management of COVID-19 positive cases. It will be set up soon.
- "Isolation center operation and management standard 2077" approved by Provincial Council of Minister. Virtual meeting among Chief District Officers (Chair of DCCMC) and Health Offices of all 12 districts in the presence of Minister and Secretary of MoSD completed to implement the standard. Joint monitoring of Isolation centers started.
- District as well as Local Level CICT orientation is ongoing.
- COVID-19 positive case management onsite coaching by consultant physician to the health service providers working in Isolation centers in remote districts is ongoing
