



Health Sector Response to Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)

Tuesday | 13 Falgun 2076 (25 February 2020)

The first case of COVID-19 was reported from Hubei Province of China on 31 December 2019. Till 24 February, a total of 79331 people have been confirmed of COVID-19 and it has taken life of 2618 people including 23 cases outside China. This disease has spread over 29 countries outside China.

Quarantine Update

Day 10 of Quarantine

All 175 Nepalese in Quarantine center have regular temperature checks. Everyone is apparently healthy. All 175 evacuees will undergo second test at the end of the quarantine period of 14 days (29th February 2020) and further actions will be taken as per the test results which is expected to come on 2nd of March 2020.

COVID-19 Hotline: Public concerns regarding COVID-19 are being addressed via 3 hotlines (9851255839, 9851255837, 9851255834) from 8:00 to 20:00 hrs.

Provincial Updates:

Health desk are operational at the main land borders crossing with China, India and at Airports; Hospitals have prepared the Hospital Disaster Preparedness and Response Plan and isolation facilities.

Hospitals are also directed to comply with the algorithm and protocol prepared by the Ministry of Health and Population.

Screening and Surveillance: Temperature of travellers coming from China, Republic of Korea, Thailand, Malaysia and Singapore is being measured through thermal scanner established at Tribhuvan International Airport (TIA) Health desk; temperature measured >100.4° F are being sent to Sukraraj Tropical and Infectious Disease Hospital for further investigation and treatment; People reporting fever, cough or shortness of breath at TIA Health Desk or Teku Hospital are further investigated, treated, counselled and monitored on a regular basis.

IEC: Information, Education and Communication materials regarding COVID-19 are distributed in key locations as well as message - based awareness notifications have been spreading via radio and television up to Federal, Province and Local Level on a regular basis.
