Health Sector Response to Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)

Saturday | 22 Chaitra 2076 (4th April 2020)

Major Activities:

- Honorable Minister, Ministry of Health and Population interacted and consulted with health sector experts on 21 Chaitra 2076 (3 April 2020) about necessary steps that MoHP should take regarding COVID-19 prevention and response initiatives.
- Following the decision of Government of Nepal to develop the designated hospitals as COVID-19 specialized hospitals, initiatives have been taken to upgrade the physical infrastructures and enhance the human resource management at Sukraraj Tropical and Infectious Disease Hospital in Teku, Kathmandu.

Logistics Management: Department of Health Services (DoHS) has been continuously supplying necessary items such as disinfectant sprayer pump, PPE, N95 masks, gowns, goggles, gloves, thermometer as per the demand and need.

Expansion of Laboratory Service: In addition to National Public Health Laboratory (NPHL), Teku, following hospitals in six different provinces are functional to test COVID-19 through PCR (Polymerase Chain Reaction).
