Major activities:



Nick Simon Institute provided 10 portable ventilators and 1000 sets of PPE to the Ministry of Health and Population

 A protocol for COVID-19 sample collection and testing has been developed by Epidemiology and Disease Control Division (EDCD) with support from Nepal Army, Nepal Armed Police Force and laboratory professionals.

Major decisions made by Government of Nepal regarding health professionals on the management of COVID-19 dated 22nd Chaitra, 2076 (4th April, 2020):


- Doctors, Nurses, technical and other health professionals involved in prevention, control and treatment of COVID 19 will be provided with Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and other items as per need, and a special provision will be made for their motivation.
- Ministry of Home Affairs will make appropriate arrangements for the safety and security of doctors, nurses, technical and other health professionals involved in prevention, control and treatment of COVID 19.
- Legal actions will be taken against individuals creating any kind of obstacles to the health workers
 engaged in the prevention, control and treatment of COVID-19. The action against such individuals
 will be as per the existing law, equivalent to the action taken against individuals hindering the
 work of the security personnel while in duty.

Logistics Management: Department of Health Services (DoHS) has been supplying necessary items such as disinfectant sprayer pump, PPE, N95 masks, gowns, goggles, gloves, thermometer as per the demand and need.

Laboratory Test: Till date, nine people have been reported as positive for COVID-19 confirmed by laboratory tests. No new cases were reported today. The first infected person has recovered and has resumed normal life, while the remaining eight infected cases are receiving COVID-19 treatment in designated hospitals.
