# **Major Activities**

- The Government of India through Indian Embassy handed over 18 different types of medicines (23 tons) to the Ministry of Health and Population (MoHP) in the presence of Honorable Minister, MoHP Mr. Bhanu Bhakta Dhakal.
- The Government of China, Tibet province provided medical items for COVID-19 testing and control (PCR machine - 2, Infrared Thermometer – 1000, Testing Kit (including VTM) – 20000, PPE set – 10000, N95 Mask - 10000 and Wet Wipe with Alcohol – 50) to MoHP. Chief Specialist Dr. Roshan Pokharel, on behalf of MoHP received these items today at 11.30 am, in Miteri Bridge, Tatopani Customs Office.
- With support from World Vision International, through Social Welfare Council, Honorable Minister, Ministry of Women, Children and Senior Citizens Mr. Parbat Gurung handed over 1000 PPE set and 10 units of thermal gun to Honorable Minister, MoHP Mr. Bhanu Bhakta Dhakal, to be distributed to health facilities in different provinces. Similarly, Rotary Club of Kathmandu and Panchakanya Group jointly handed over 2 swab collection booths to MoHP.

#### **Logistics Management**

Department of Health Services (DoHS) has been supplying necessary items such as disinfectant sprayer pump, PPE, N95 masks, gowns, goggles, gloves, thermometer as per the demand and need.

A total of 2144 people received services from two COVID-19 call centers (1115 and 1133) today.






# **Laboratory Test**

Forty-five (45) people have been reported as positive for COVID-19 till date. Three new positive cases were reported today. Seven infected individuals have recovered and resumed normal life, while the remaining 38 infected people are receiving treatment in different COVID-19 hospitals.
