



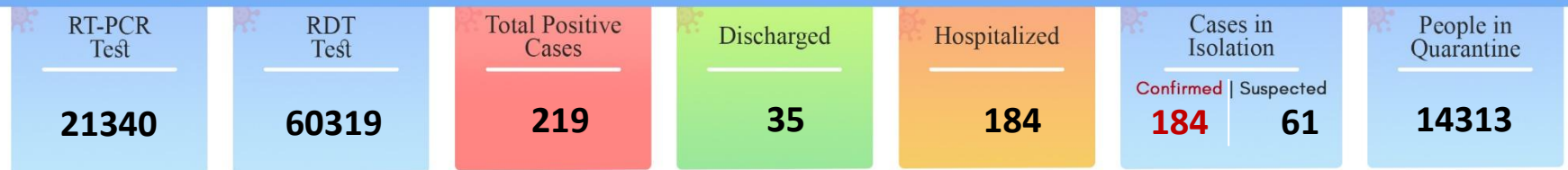

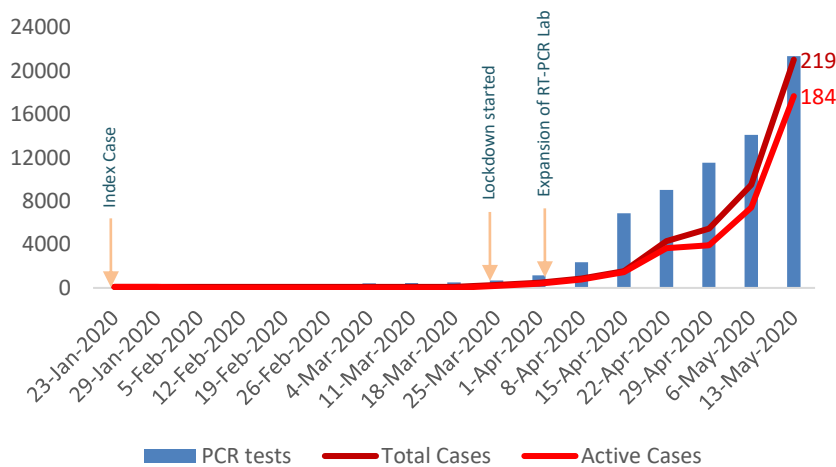

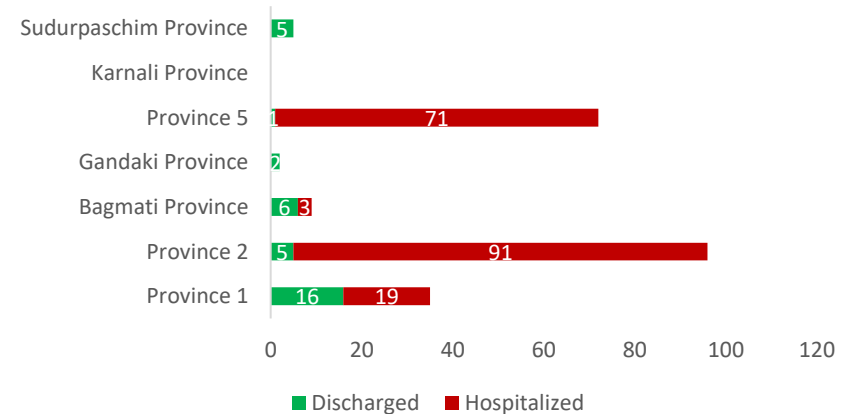

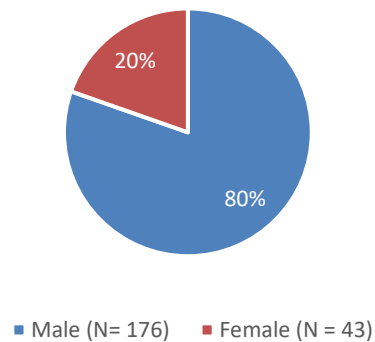
PCR Test and COVID-19 Cases



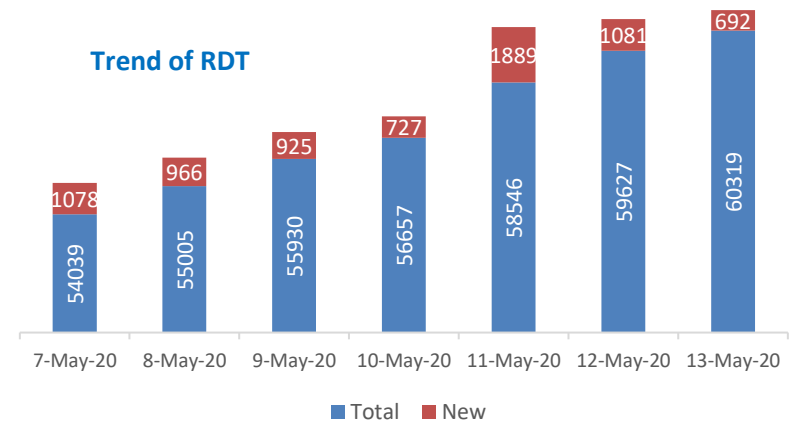
Province-wise distribution of COVID-19 cases



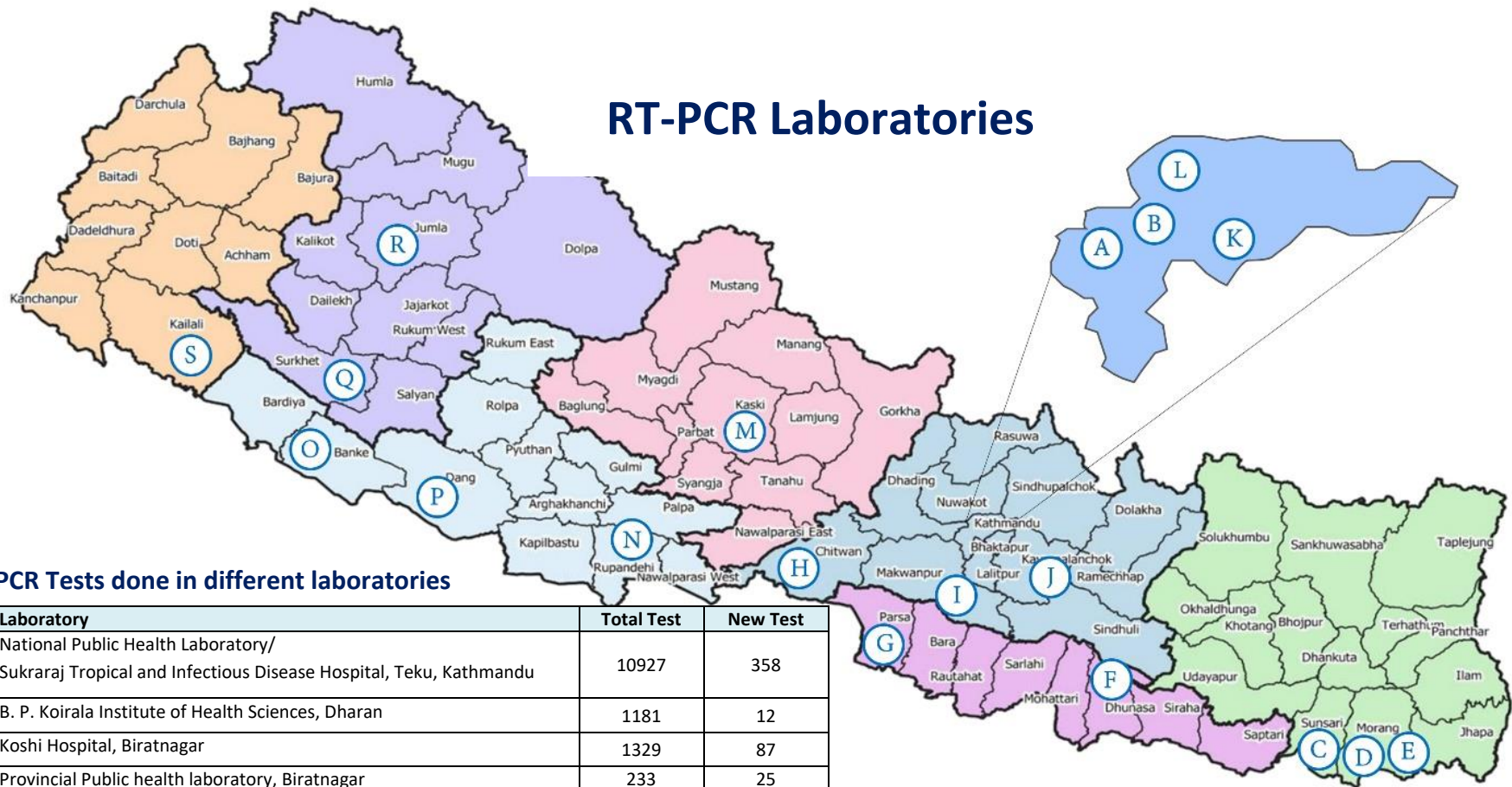
Sex wise distribution of COVID-19 Cases

- Two people, a twenty-five years male and a sixty-three years female were discharged after 11 and 26 days of hospitalization from Corona Hospital, Butwal Thread Factory and Corona Hospital, Bharatpur respectively after negative PCR tests. Thus, the total number of discharged cases is 35.
