



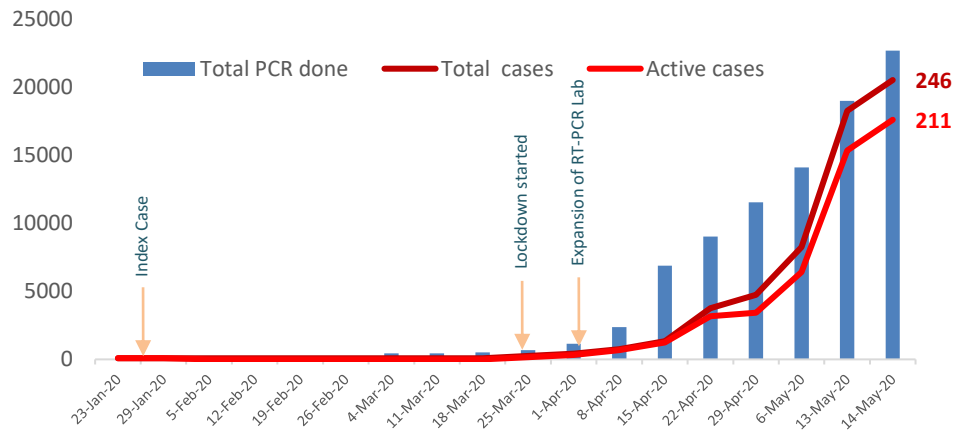

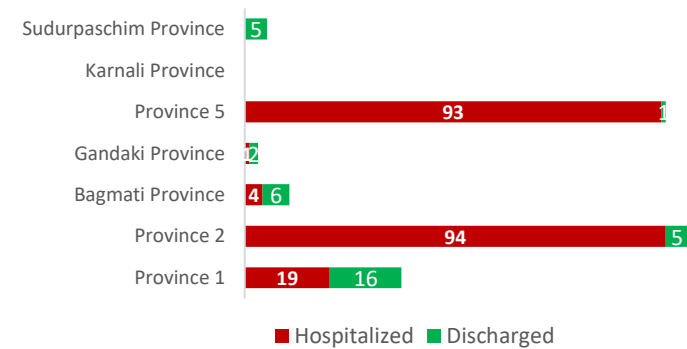

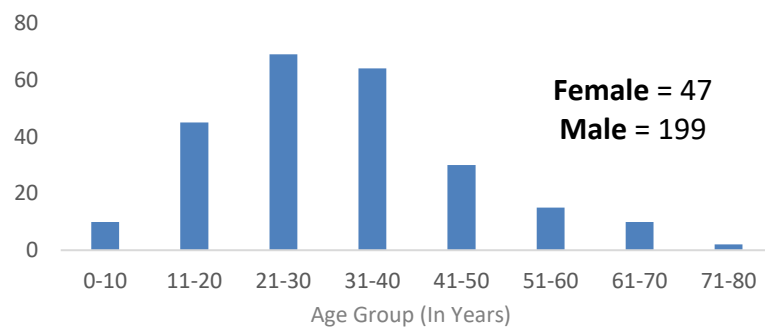
Trend of RT-PCR and active Cases



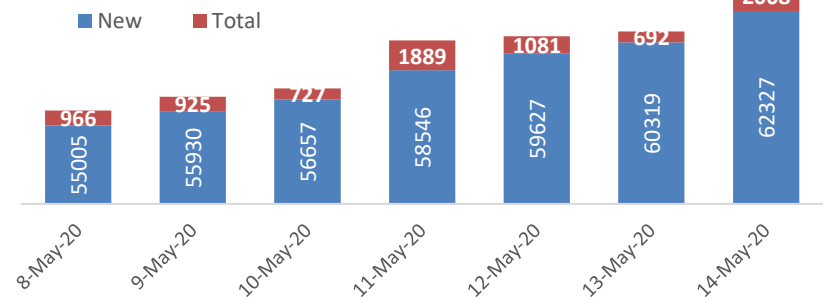
Province-wise distribution of COVID-19 Cases



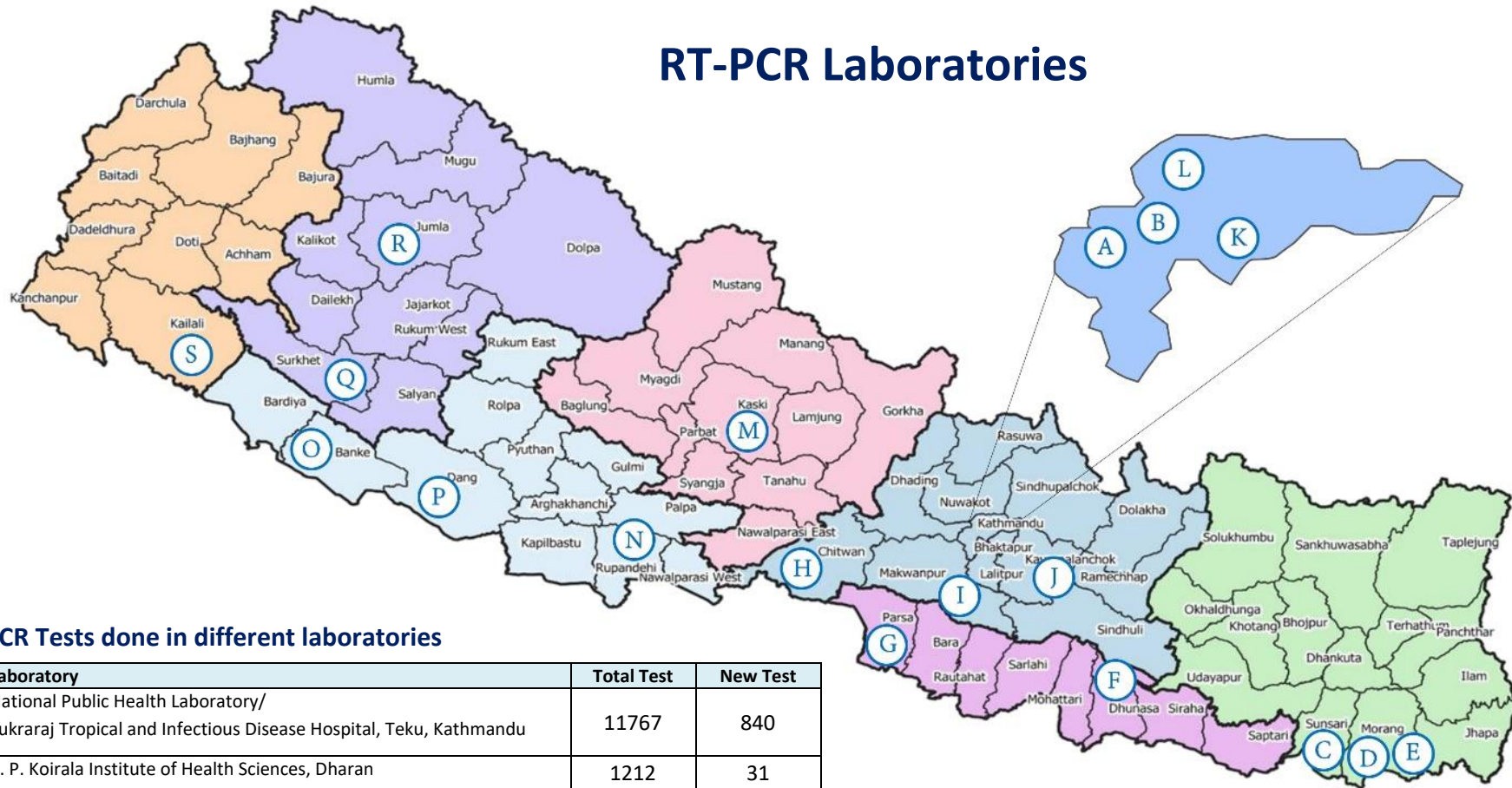
Distribution of Cases according to Age Group
