Friday | 15 Chaitra 2076 (28 March 2020)

The first case of COVID-19 was reported from Hubei Province of China on 31 December 2019. Till 25 March 2020, a total of 512701 people have been confirmed of COVID-19 and it has taken life of 23495 people. This disease has spread over 201 countries/ Territories.

In addition, "COVID-19 call center" has been operated from 6 am to 10 pm, from 13 March for NTC and N-cell network users. Dial "1115" for this free service.

And, 24 hours "COVID-19 call center" has been initiated from 15 Chaitra 2076 for NTC and N-cell network users. Dial "1133" for this free service.

-Under the command of respected Secretary "Incident Command System" has been operated at health emergency operation centre

- A skype call was arranged today, on 28 March 2020 to orient health officials of Ministry of Social Development and the Health Directorate of Sudurpaschim Province about the SOP of Case Investigation and Contact Tracing
- Contact tracing of the 4th case of COVID-19 has been started and for the technical facilitation of additional contact tracing at local level, a team with doctor has been mobilized to Dhangadi.
- No symptoms of COVID-19 have been observed among the contacts of positive cases till date after the contact tracing.
- -The sample test of suspected family members of the second case (19-year-old woman) was found to be negative.
