Major activities:

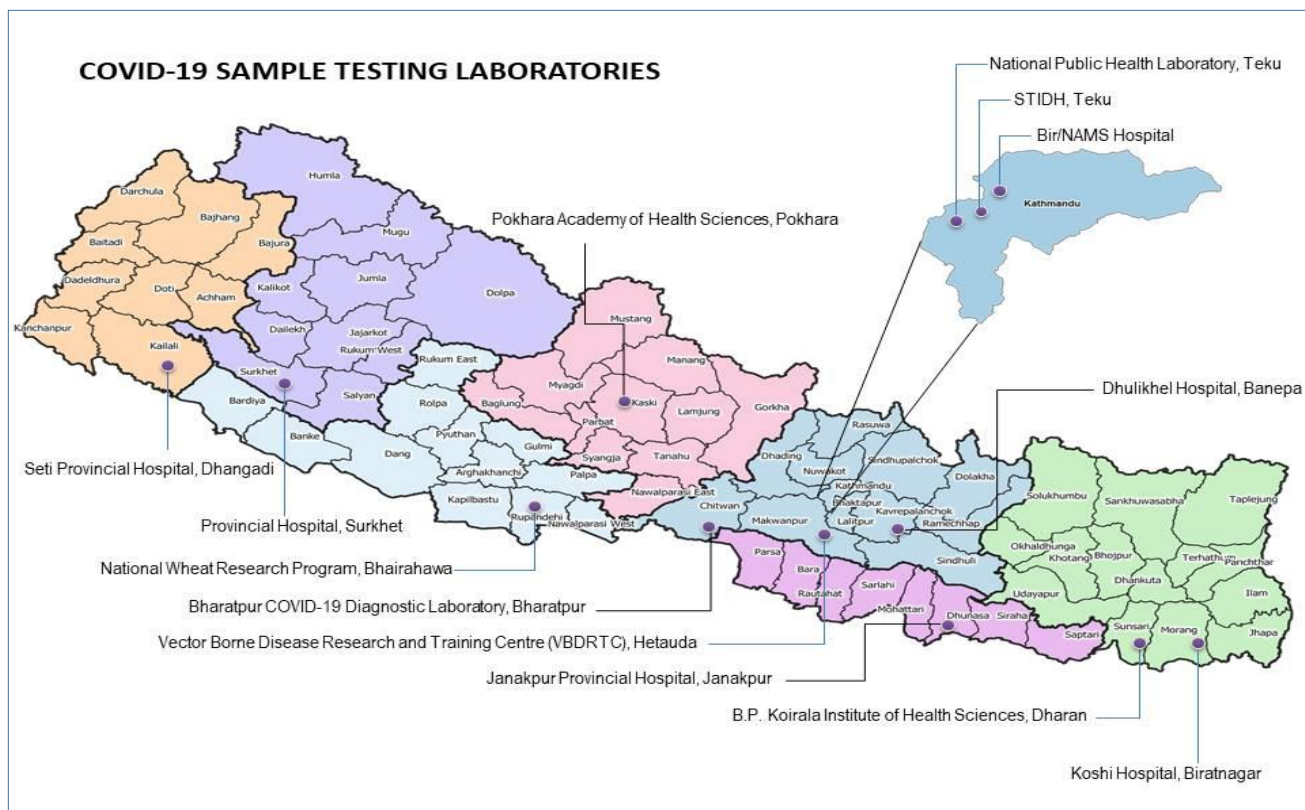
- Non-Resident Nepali Association – National Coordination Council (NRNA-NCC) of South Korea has provided 4000 PCR reagent kits and 475 PPE to the Ministry of Health and Population.
- Ministry of Health and Population received 150,000 Hydroxy Chloroquine (200mg) tablets from Deurali Janata Pharmaceuticals Private Limited.
- Technical team from Epidemiology and Disease Control Division (EDCD) and Nepal Armed Police Force collected 460 samples from six different locations of Darchula district on 29th Chaitra, 2076 (11th April, 2020) and brought them to Kathmandu for lab testing.
- Contact tracing of recently diagnosed three positive cases of COVID-19 in Birgunj Metropolitan City of Parsa has been started.

Logistics Management: Department of Health Services (DoHS) has been supplying necessary items such as disinfectant sprayer pump, PPE, N95 masks, gowns, goggles, gloves, thermometer as per the demand and need.

Laboratory Test: Till date, twelve people have been reported positive for COVID-19 confirmed by laboratory tests. Three new positive cases were reported today. The first infected person has recovered and has resumed normal life, while the remaining eleven infected cases are receiving COVID-19 treatment in designated hospitals.
