- Expressions of interest shall be delivered online through e-GP system <u>www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp</u>or manually to the addressNepal Police Headquarters, Crime Investigation Department, Naxal, Kathmanduon or before 29 December 2017, 12:00 hours.
- 6. In case the last date of obtaining and submission of the EOI documents happens to be a holiday, the next working day will be deemed as the due date but the time will be the same as stipulated.
- EOI will be assessed based on *Qualification [30%], Experience [50%],* and *Capacity [20%*] of consulting firm and key personnel. Based on evaluation of EOI, only shortlisted firms will be invited to submit technical and financial proposal through a request for proposal.
- 8. Minimum score to pass the EOI is 65%.
