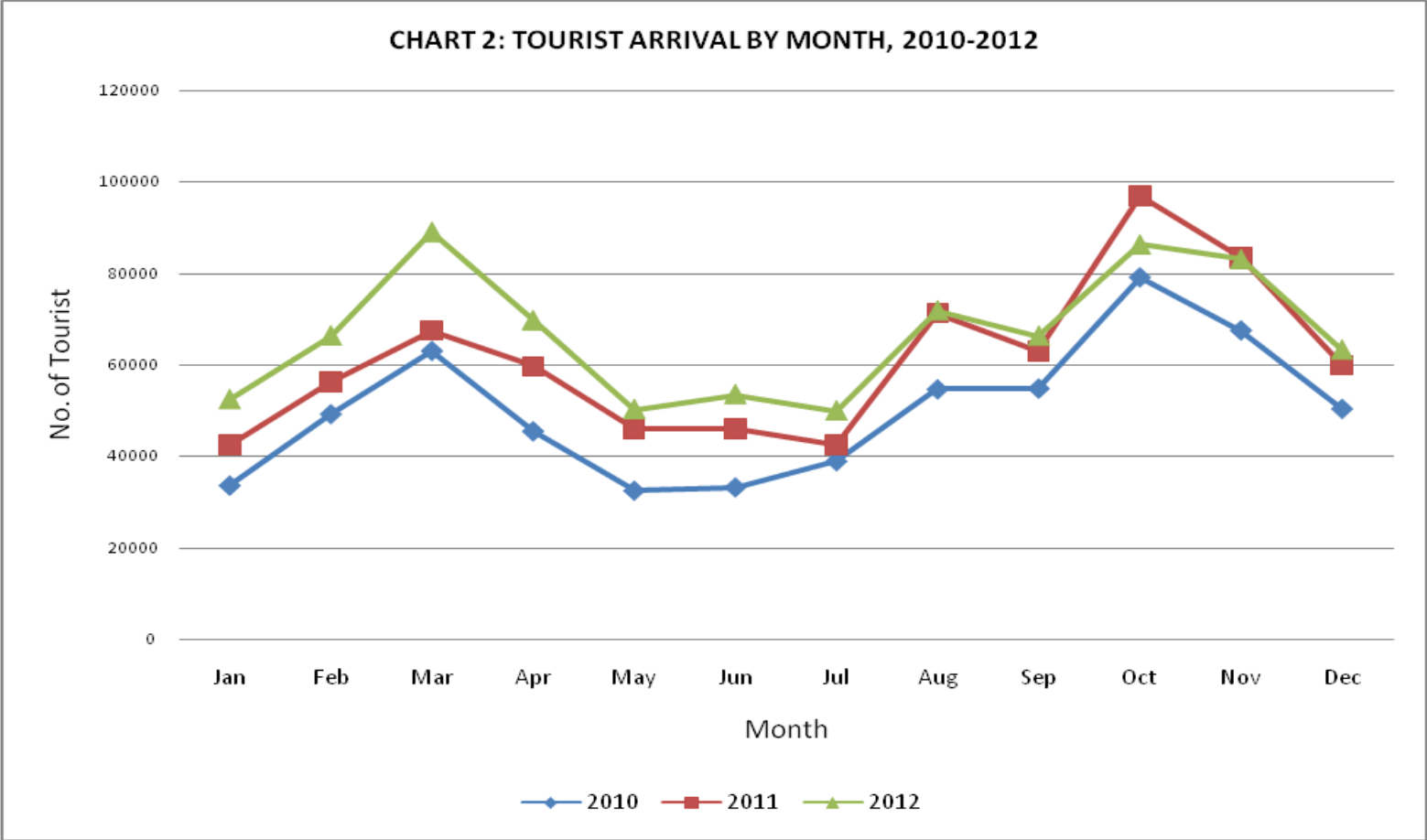

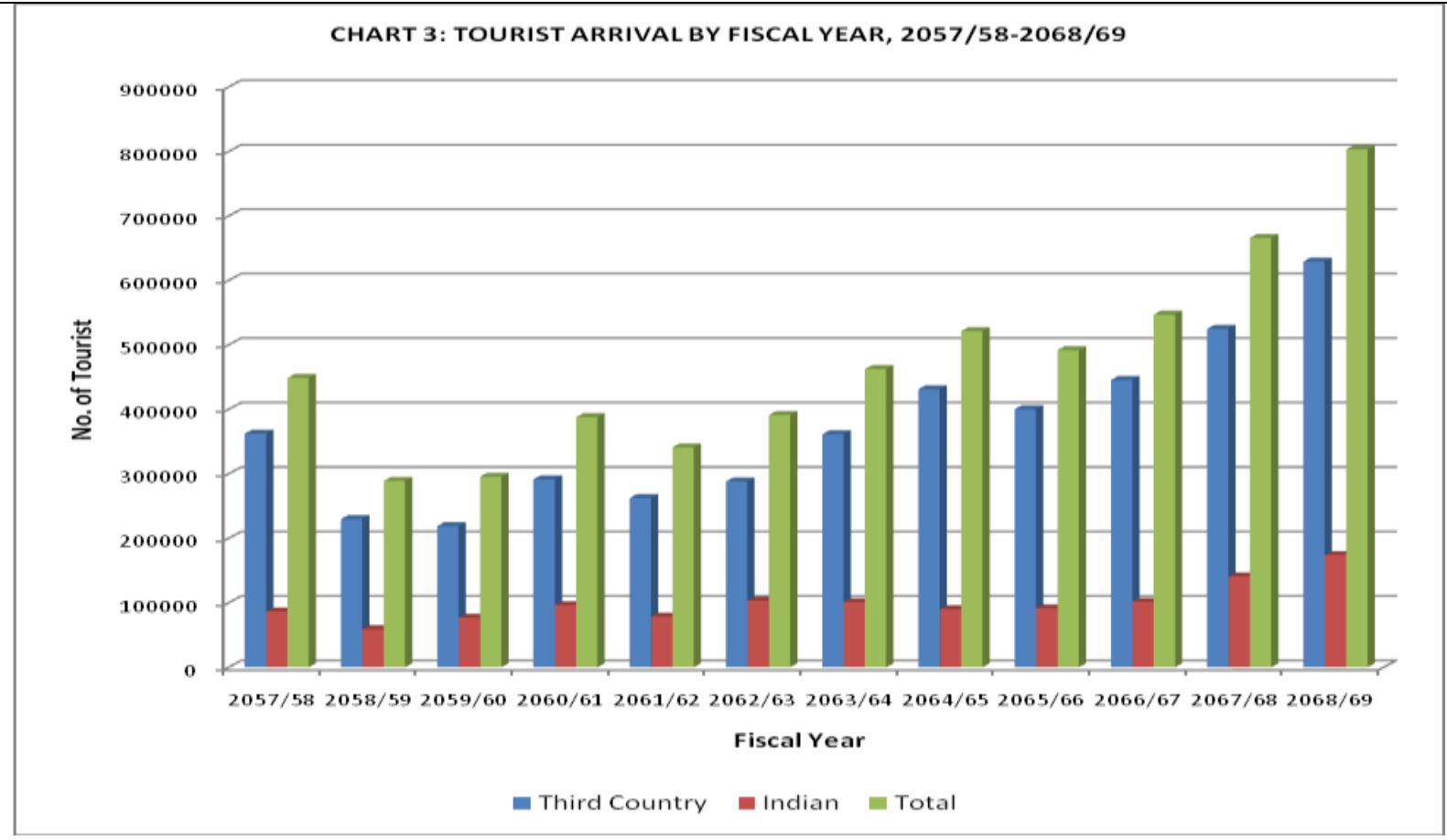

CHART 4: TOURIST ARRIVAL BY SEX, 2000-2012

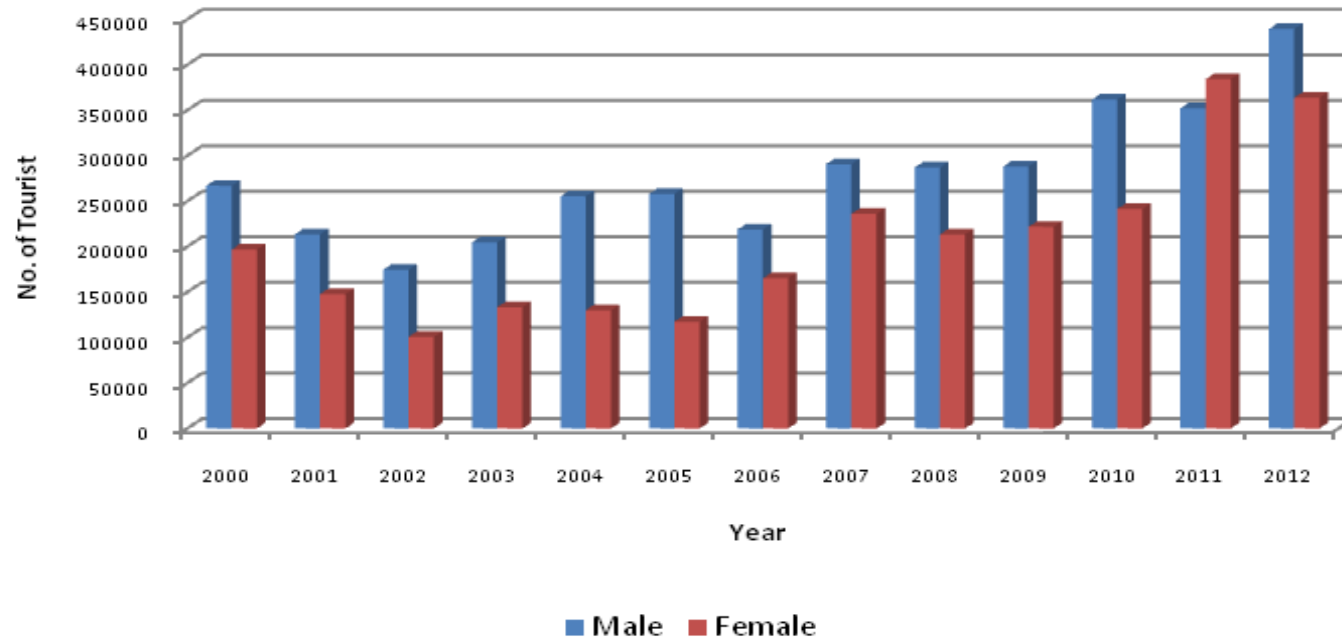

CHART 5: TOURIST ARRIVAL BY AGE GROUPS, 2012

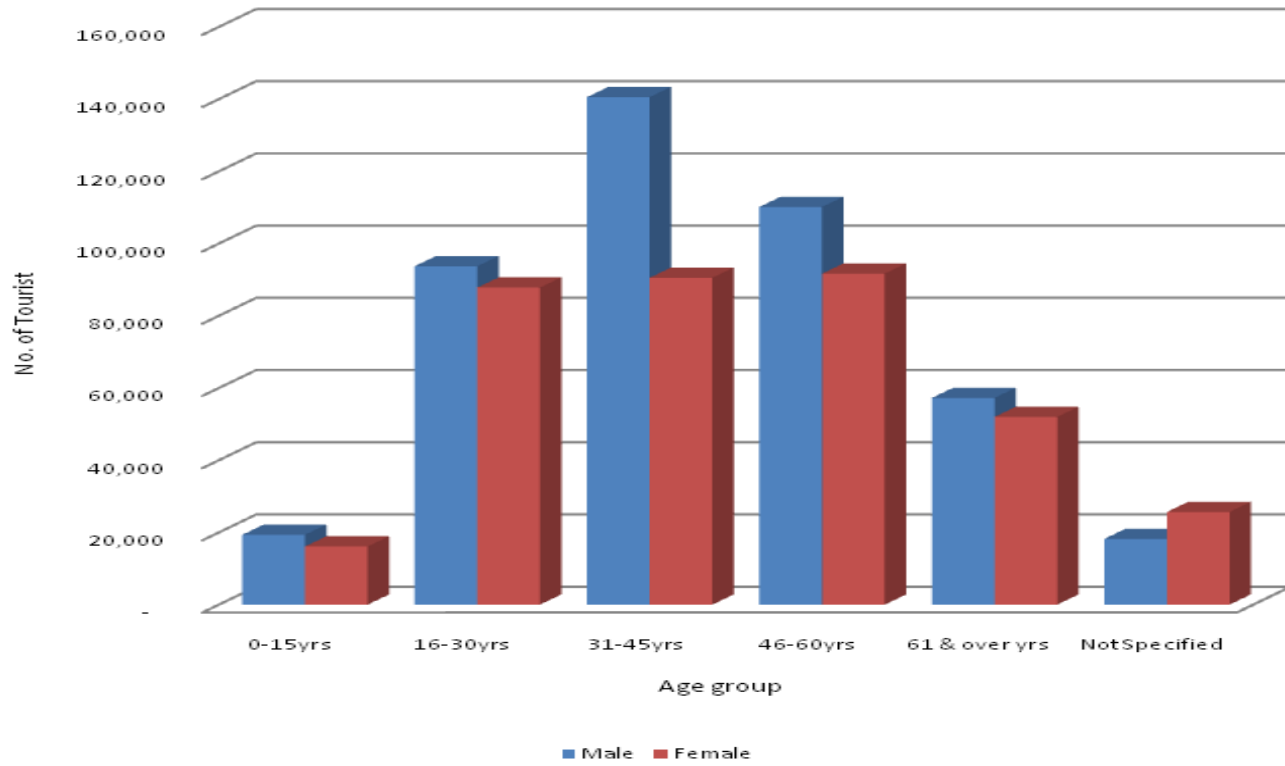

CHART 6: TOURIST ARRIVAL BY PURPOSE OF VISIT, 2012

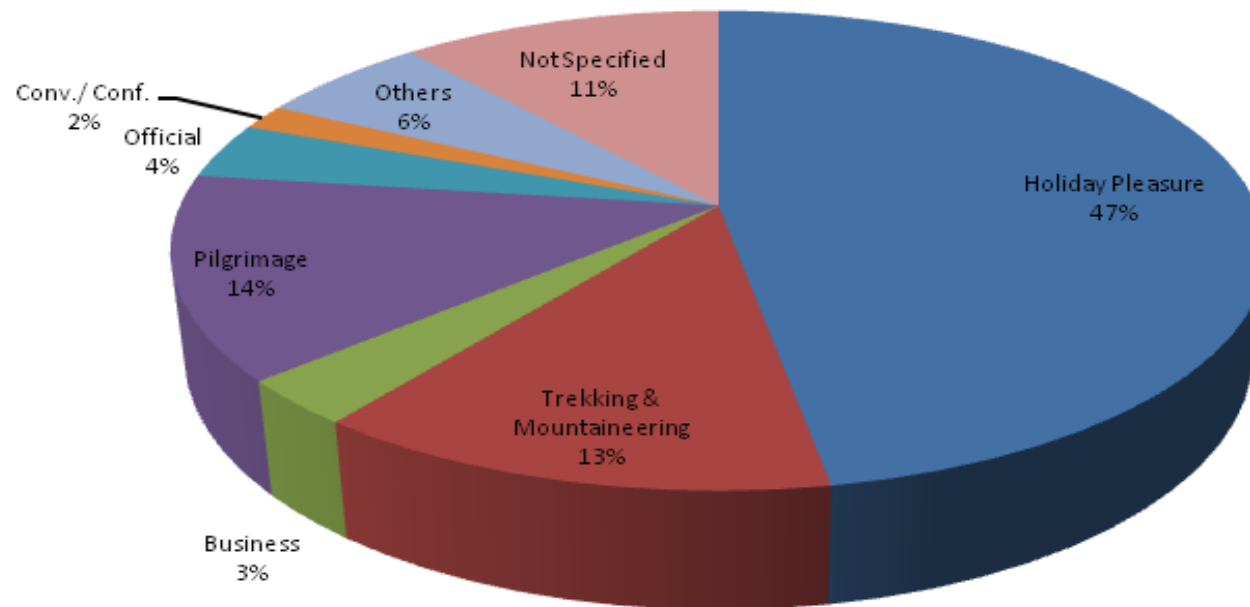

CHART 7: NUMBER OF TREKKERS IN DIFFERENT TREKKING AREAS, 2012

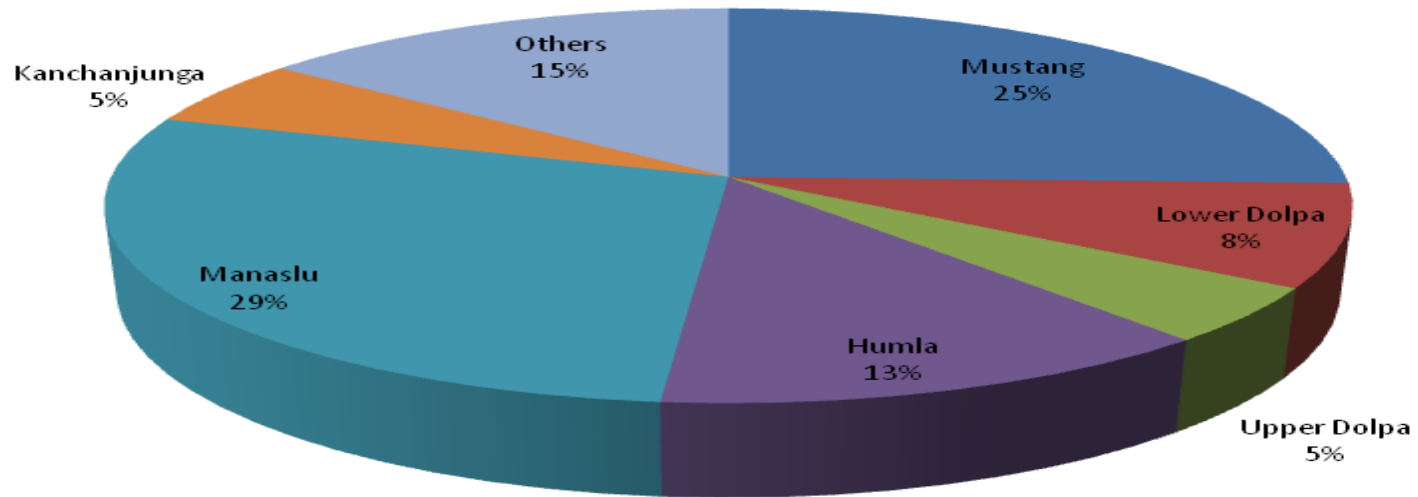

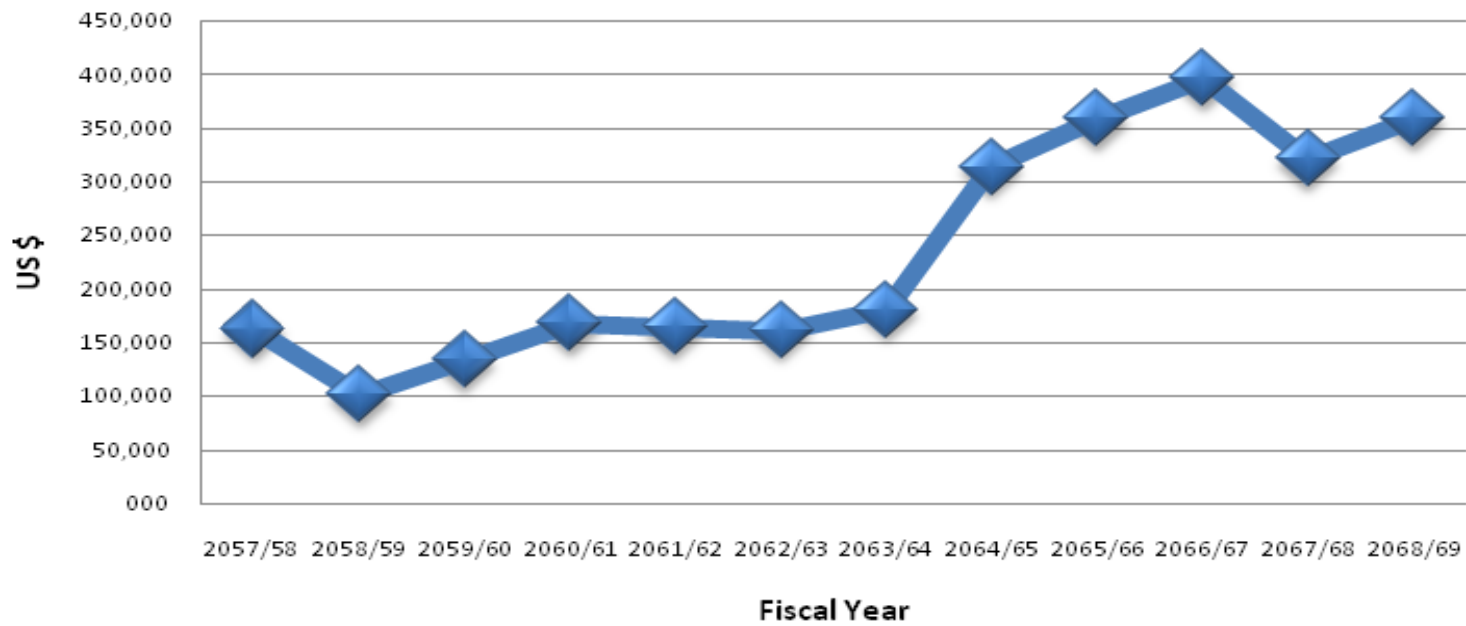

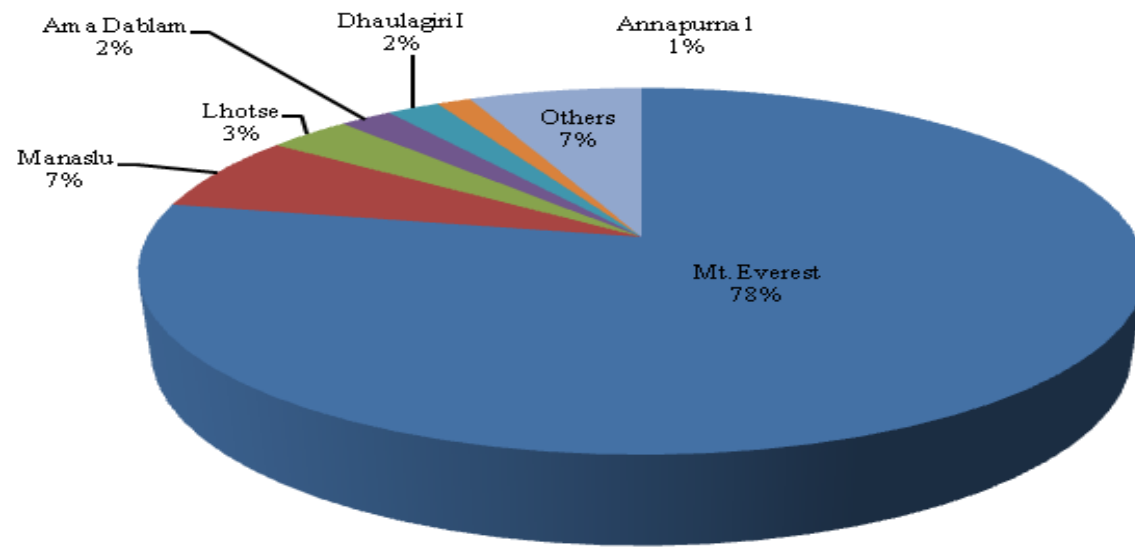

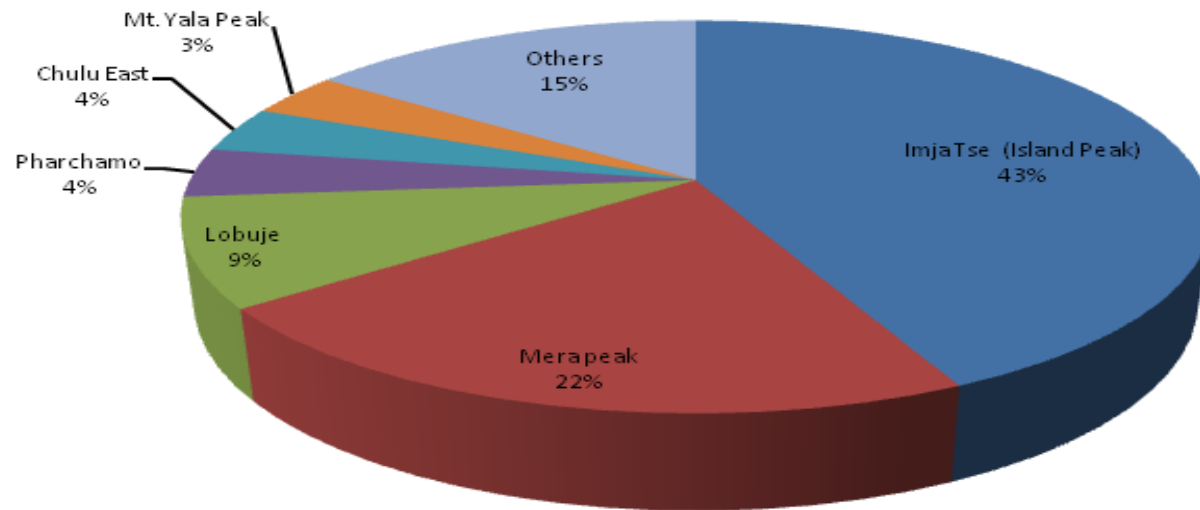

CHART 11: ROOM OCCUPANCY RATE OF FIVE STAR HOTELS, 2012

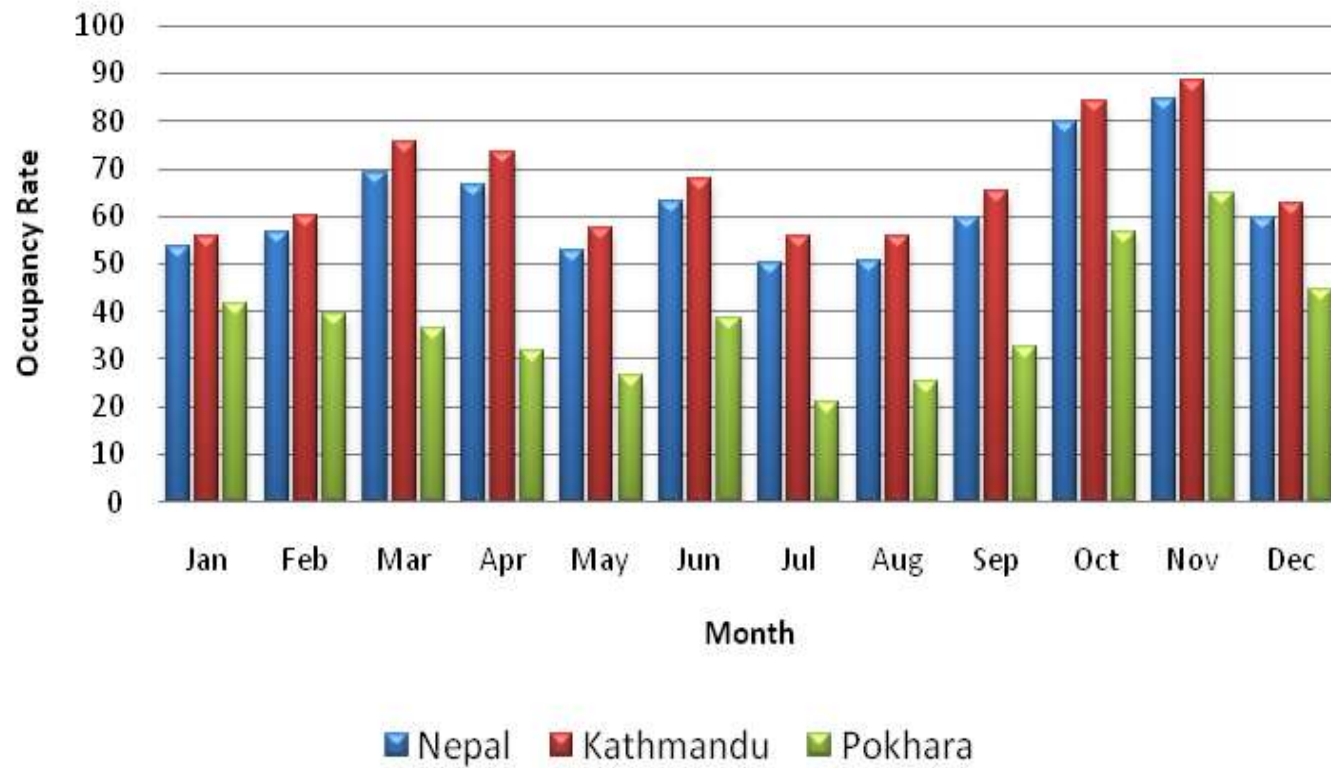
