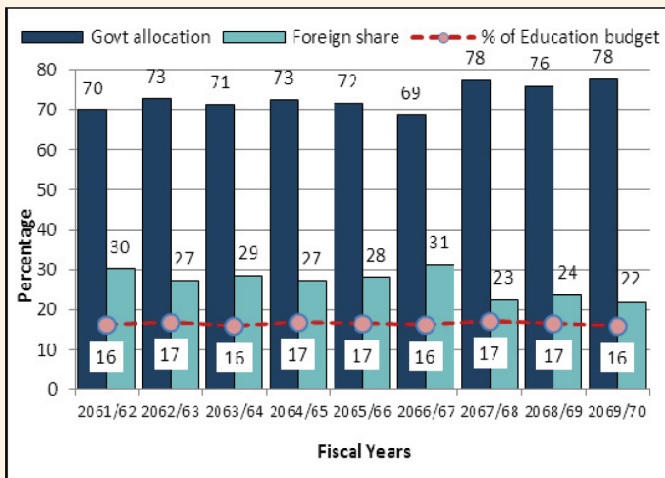

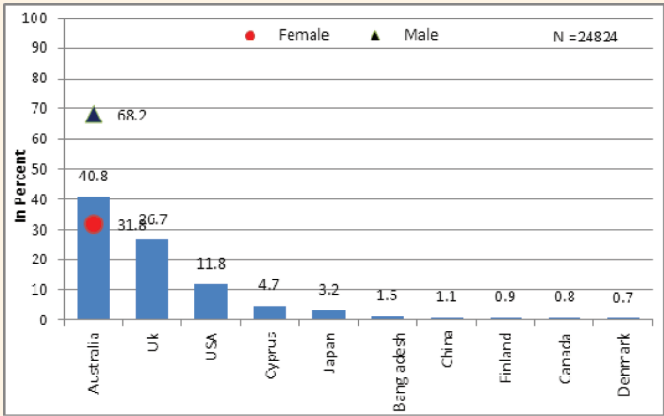

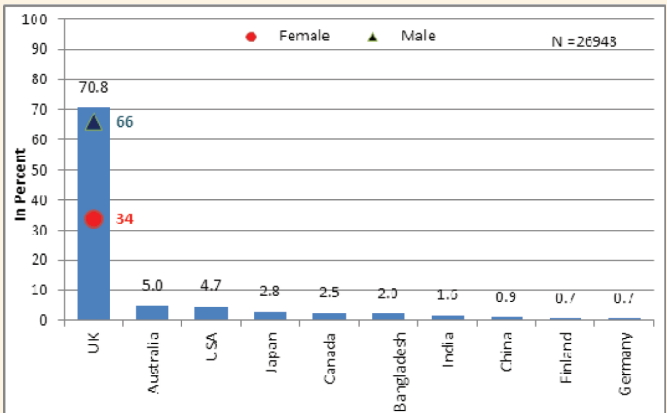

### a. Top Ten Destinations studying abroad in the FY 2065/66

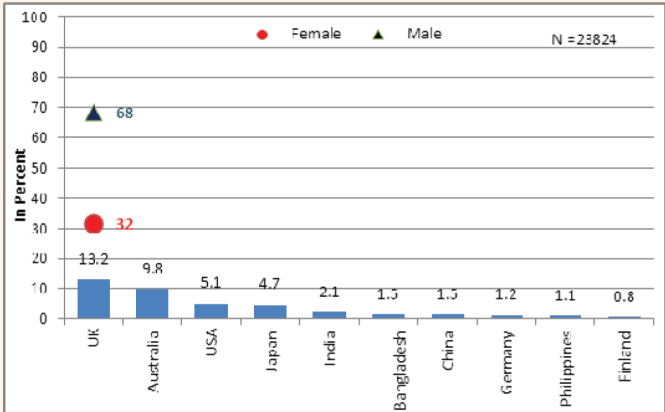

### b. Top Ten Destinations studying abroad in the FY 2066/67

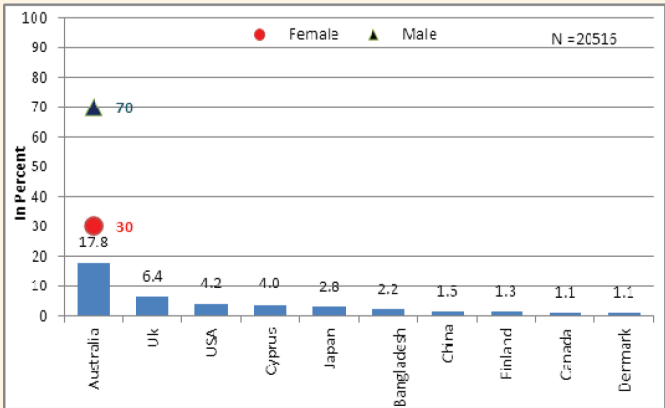


**c. Top Ten Destinations in the FY 2067/04/01 to 2068/03/31**

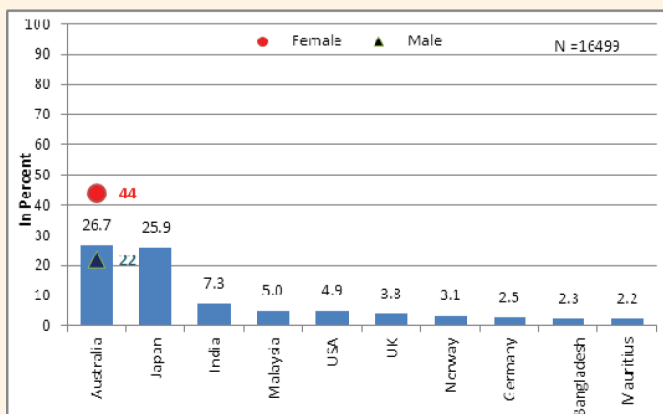
**d. Top Ten Destinations in the FY 2068/04/01 to 2069/03/31**
