4.1. Agenda One: Approval of Procurement & Grants Plan Package 8.5 (PGPP 8.5)

4.1.1. Accountable Entity Procurement Policy & Guidelines, MCC-DCO-2008.37.8, Effective January 1, 2024 (herein after "AE PPG or PPG") required to be followed by MCA-Nepal as a condition of the Compact states that MCA-Nepal shall periodically prepare a Procurement Plan for acquiring goods, works, and consultant and non-consultant services needed to implement the Compact. It also provides the matrix of approval authorities and threshold in monetary value of the contracts

Section 3.6 (a) of the MCC-Nepal Compact signed on 2017 requires that MCA-Nepal make procurement compliance, satisfactory to MCC, with the board approval shall be a condition precedent to MCC disbursements or payments and Attachment A, PPG Approval Matrix requires this Procurement to be taken to the MCA-Nepal Board.

4.1.2. The approved PGPP requires revision and amendments due to ongoing procurement for various projects. The PGPP 8.4 was approved by the Board in its 42nd Meeting of the Board of Directors held on 08 July, 2024 (2081/03/24 BS). The annexed document provides background and justification to items where amendments are being caused in the PGPP.

4.1.3. RESOLVED THAT the Board of Directors approves the Procurement and Grants Plan Package (PGPP) 8.5.

4.2. Agenda Two: Consent for Signing of Project Cooperation Agreement (“PCA”) with Forest Product Development Board (FPDB)

4.2.1. Millennium Challenge Account Nepal Development Board (Formation) Order 2074 (2018) prescribes execution of Project Cooperation Agreement with Project Partners as one of the functions, duties and rights of the Board of Director of MCA-Nepal. Pursuant to paragraph C.2 of Annex I of the Compact, the achievement of project objectives requires assistance for which the Government may engage one or more of its Project Partners having relation to the Projects.

4.2.2. The required assistance and cooperation between MCA-Nepal and the Project Partner for implementing various aspects of the Projects is set out in the PCA which defines the appointment of the designated official responsible for communication and certification upon request of all comments, approvals, authorizations, and other notices of the Project Partner to MCA-Nepal or MCC.

4.2.3. RESOLVED THAT the Board of Directors, as per the proposal submitted by MCA-Nepal, hereby authorize Executive Director of MCA-Nepal to sign the Project Cooperation Agreement with Forest Product Development Board (FPDB).
