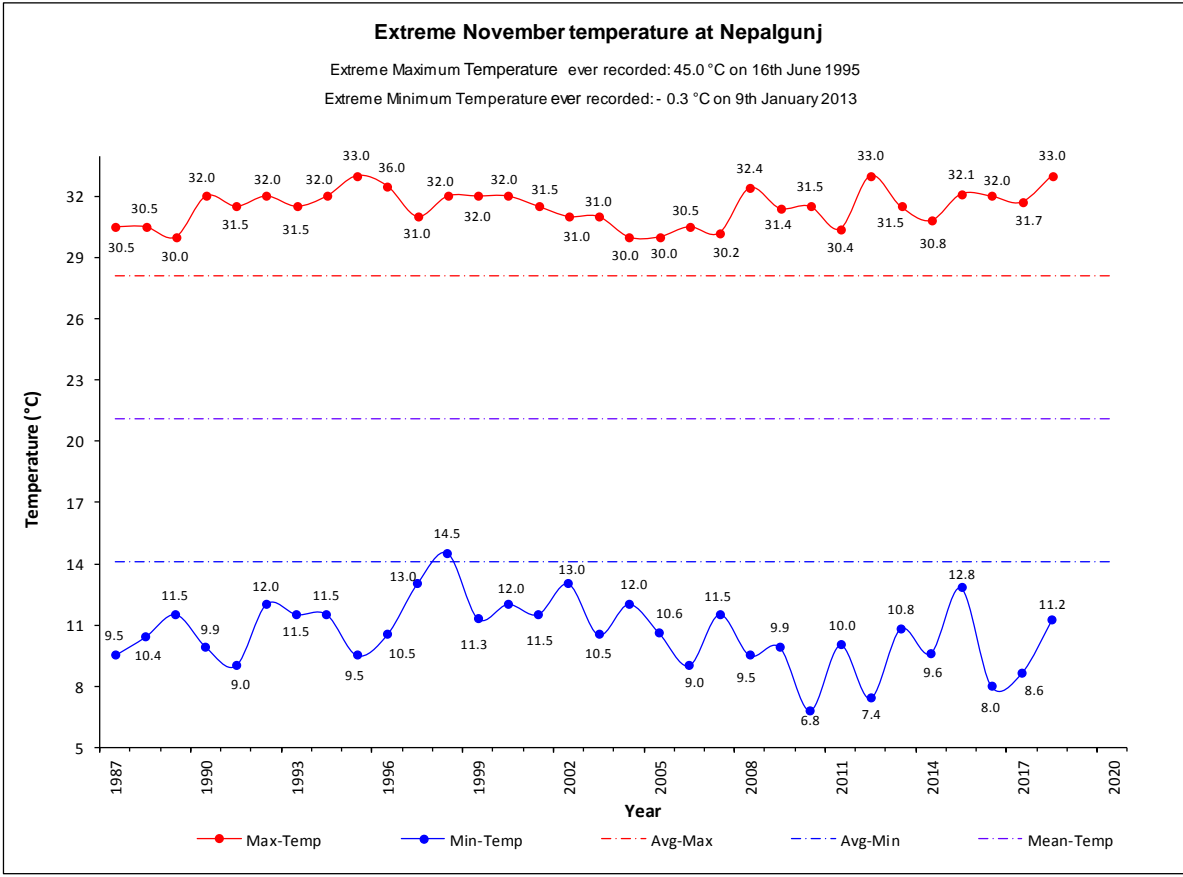
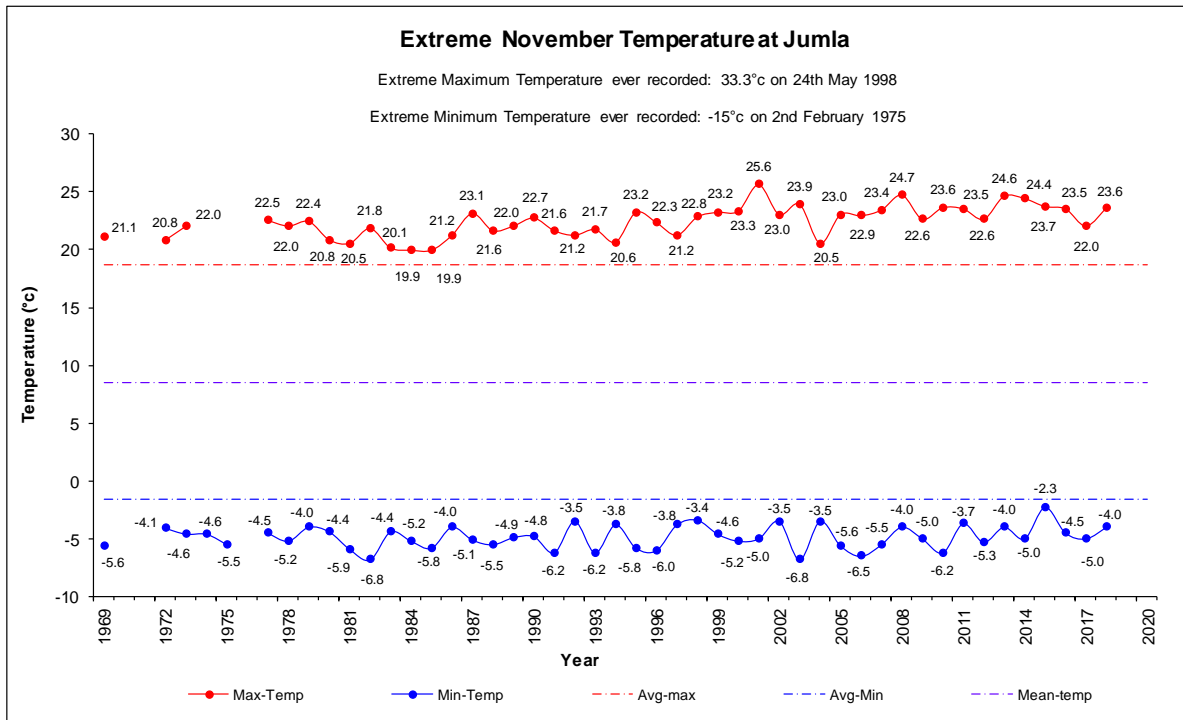
EXTREME TEMPERATURES OF NOVEMBER

Note: The continued good weather in this month makes the condition overwhelming in Nepal. November days remain quite warm in many parts of Nepal, though temperatures can be cold at night, especially towards the end of the month. Expect daytime temperatures in the low 20s Celsius in Kathmandu and Pokhara. November is the driest of all the months, temperatures become more comfortable in the Terai region, and there is usually no rainfall throughout the country.

Though this is not the coldest month the temperatures are sometime recorded minimum in some of the stations towards the end of the month. Among the stations selected in this monitoring the maximum temperature recorded in November at Dipayal in the Far-western region of Nepal of 35.2°C on 4th November 2001 and for the minimum temperature recorded in November at Jumla in the Mid-western region of Nepal of -6.8°C on 28th November 1982 and 2003. Table 1 shows the trends in the stations listed below.

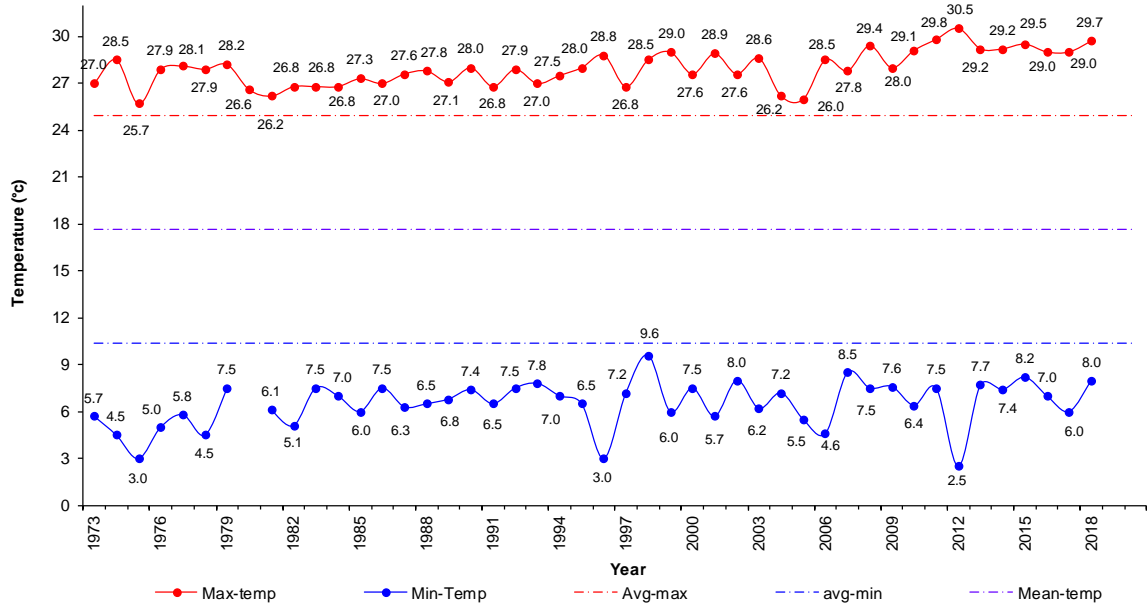






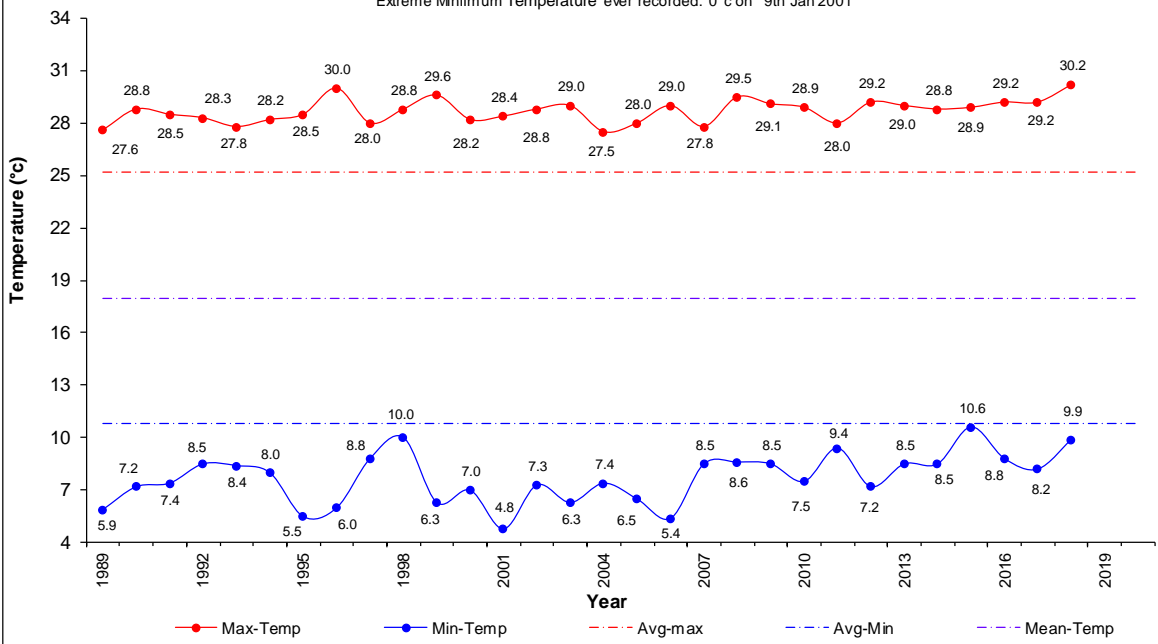

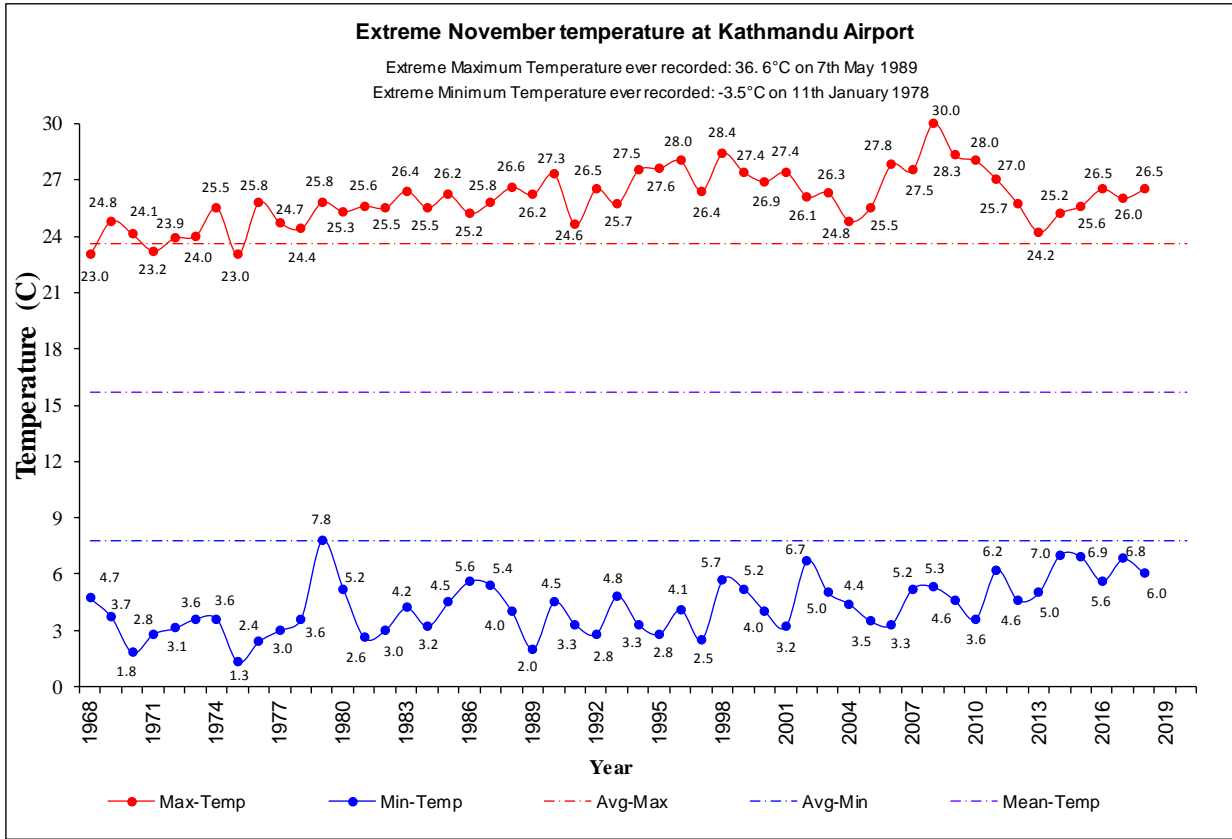
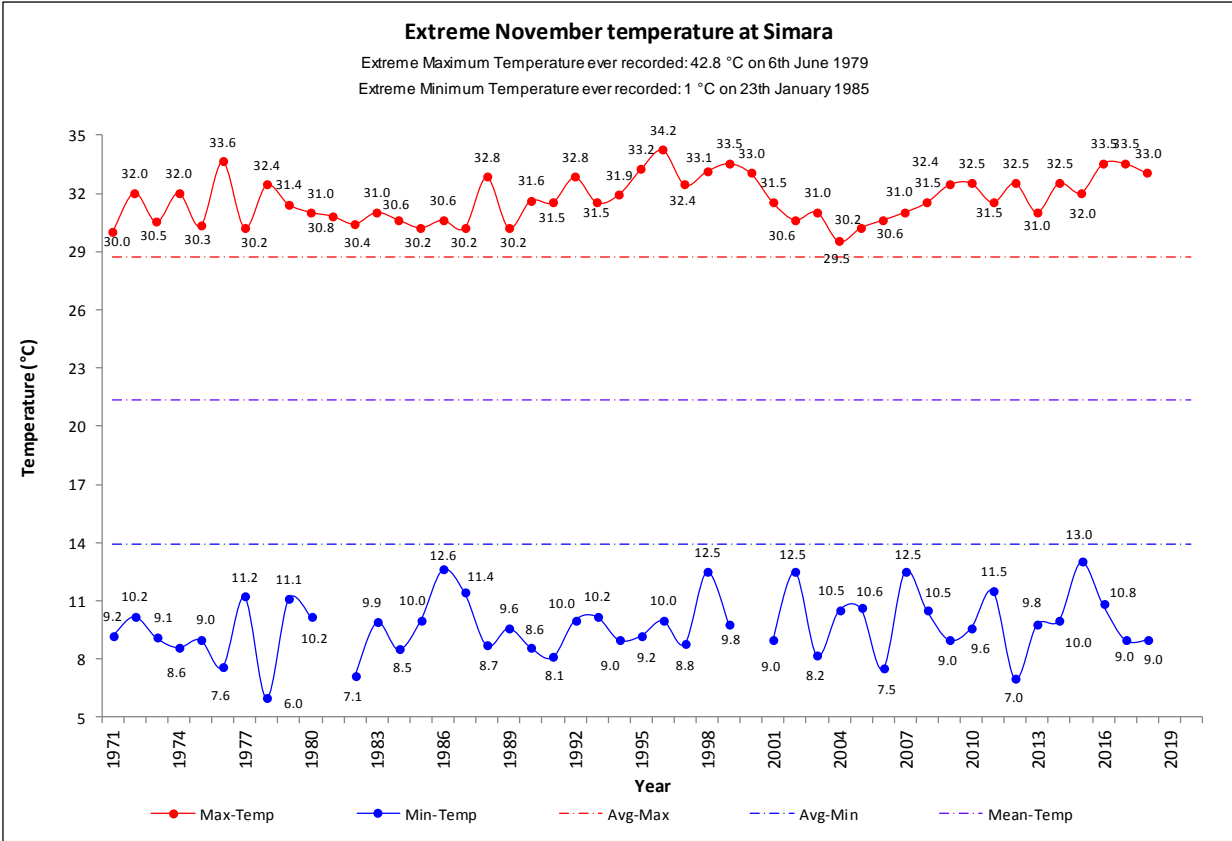


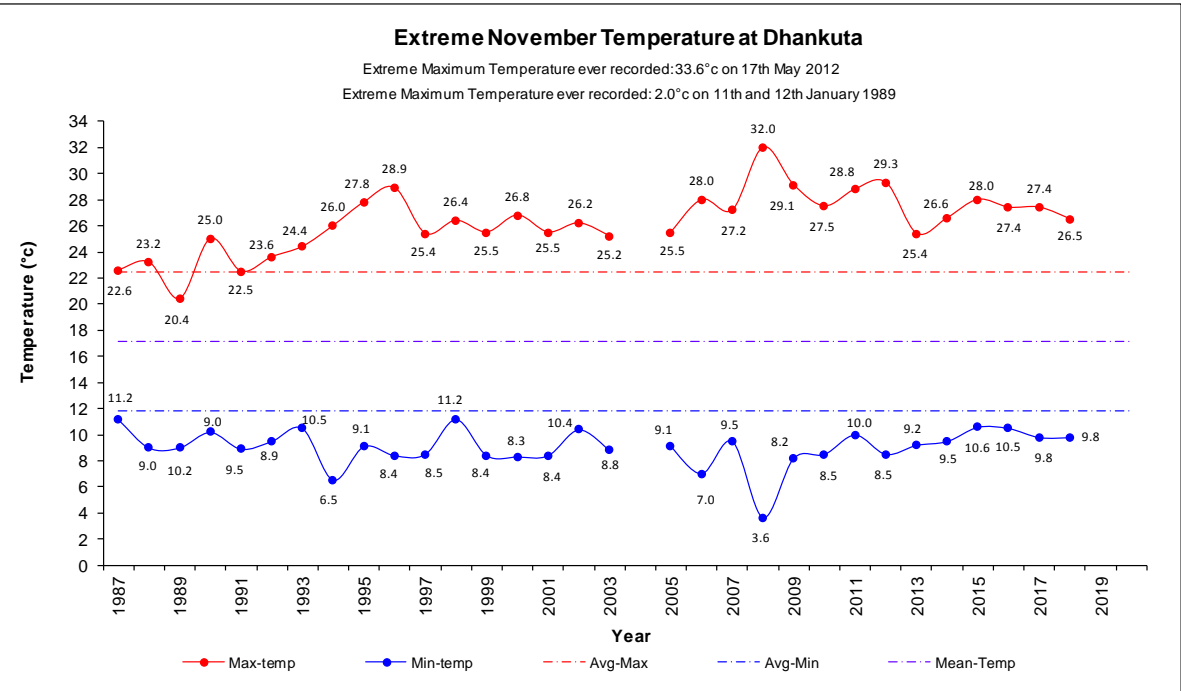
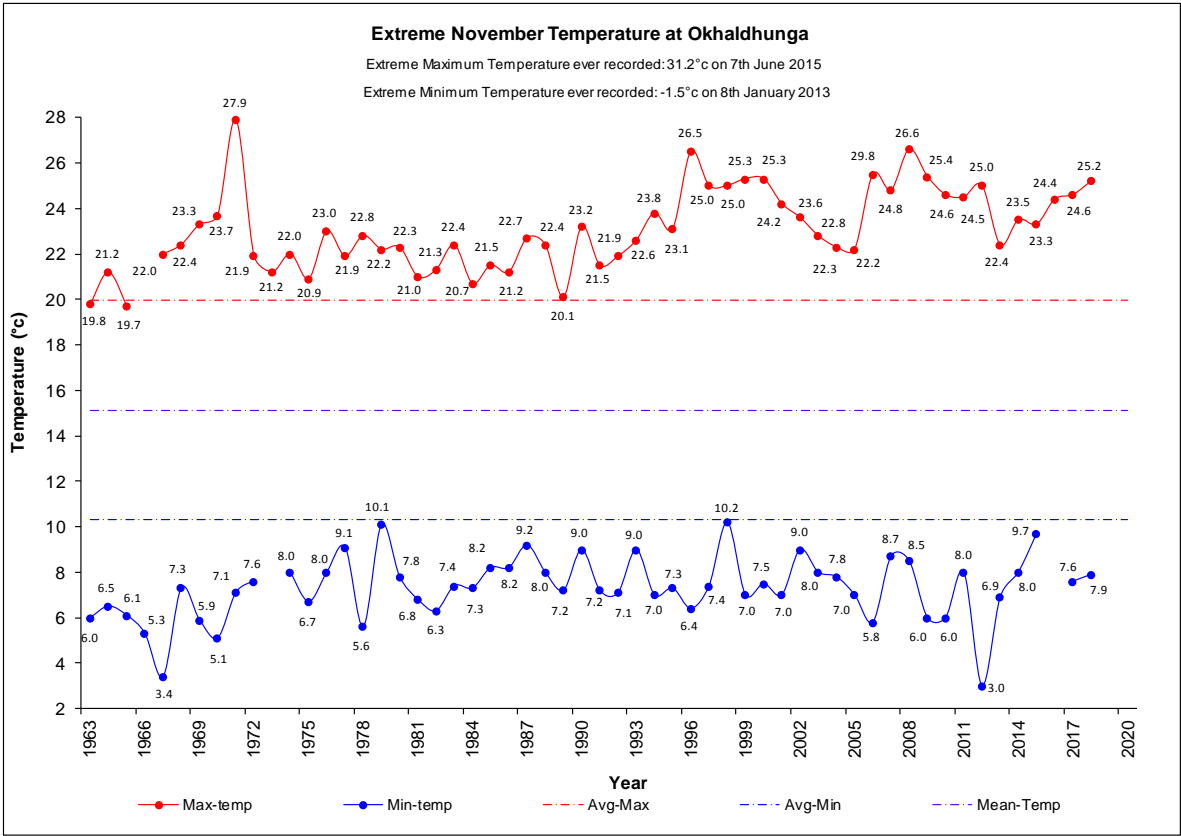
Extreme November Temperature at Dang

 Extreme Minimum Temperature ever recorded: 0 °C on 9th Jan 2001



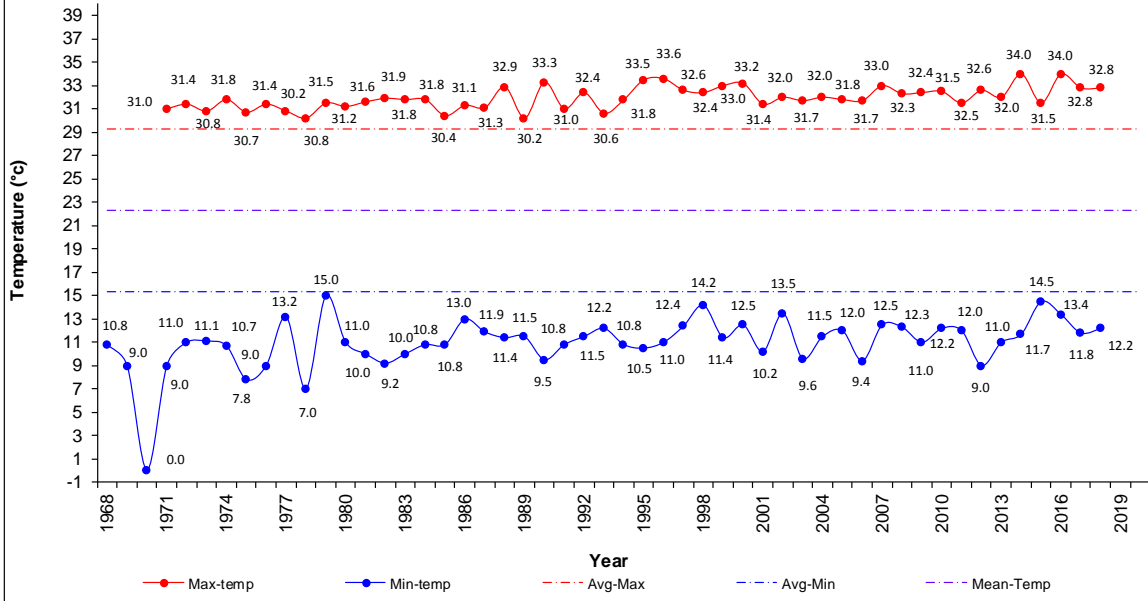






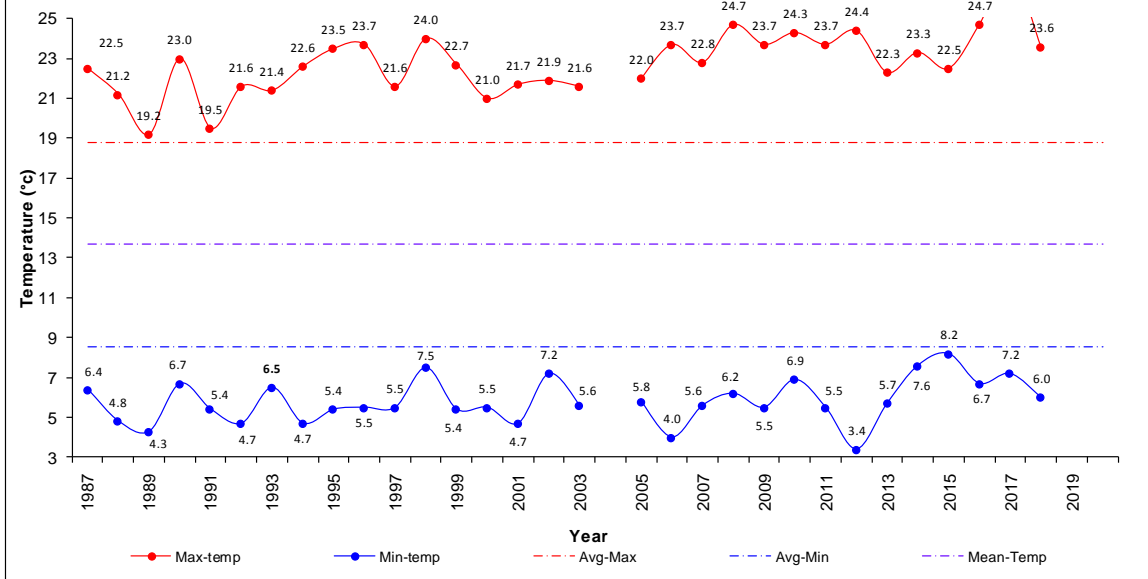
Extreme November Temperature at Biratnagar

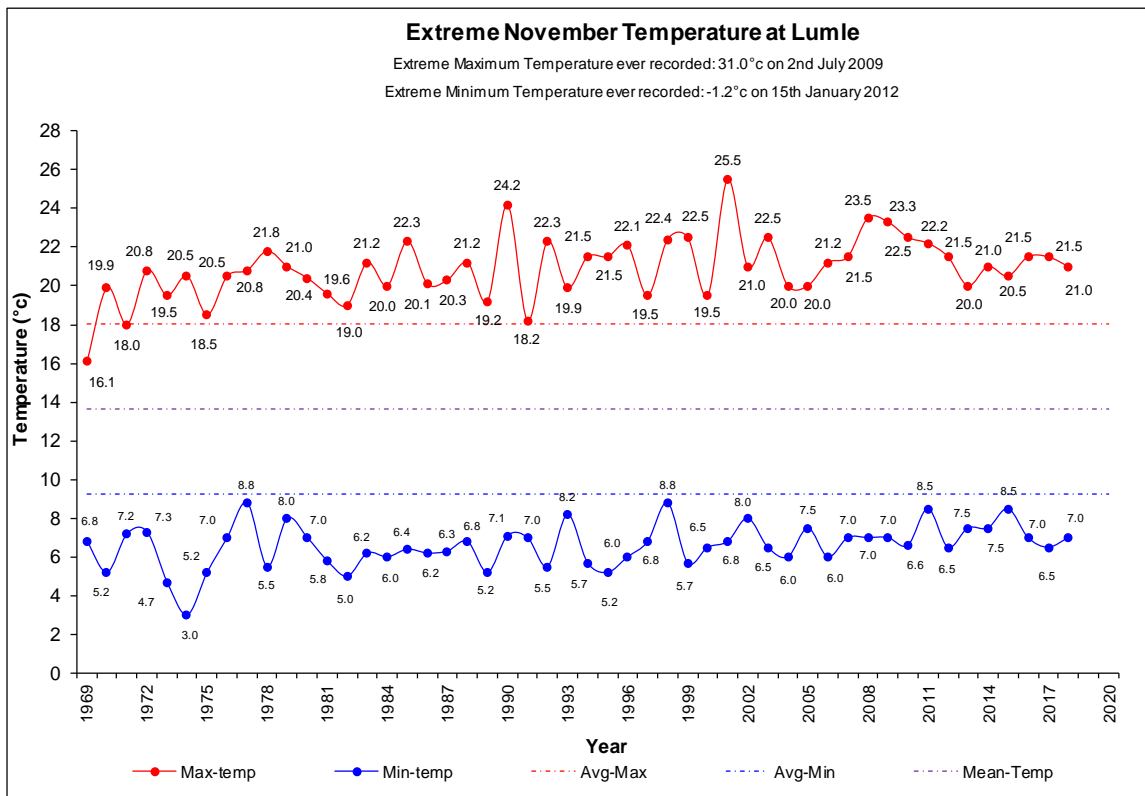
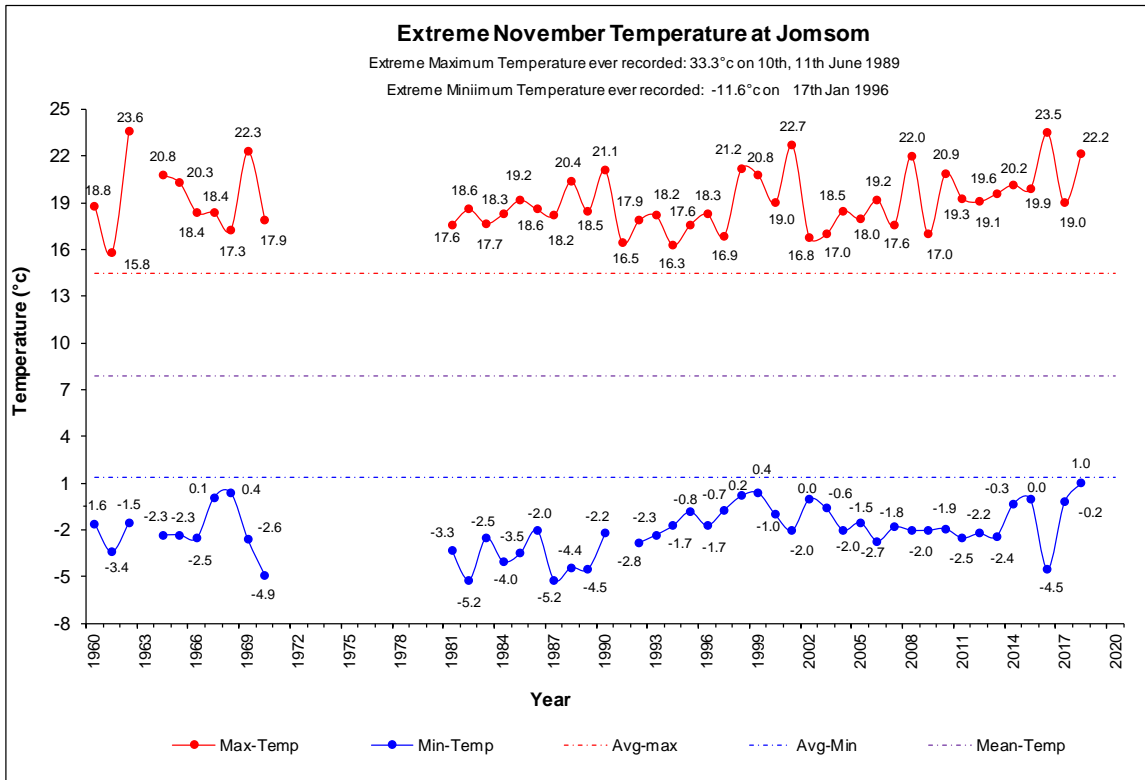

 Extreme Minimum Temperature ever recorded: -1 °C on 17th January 1991

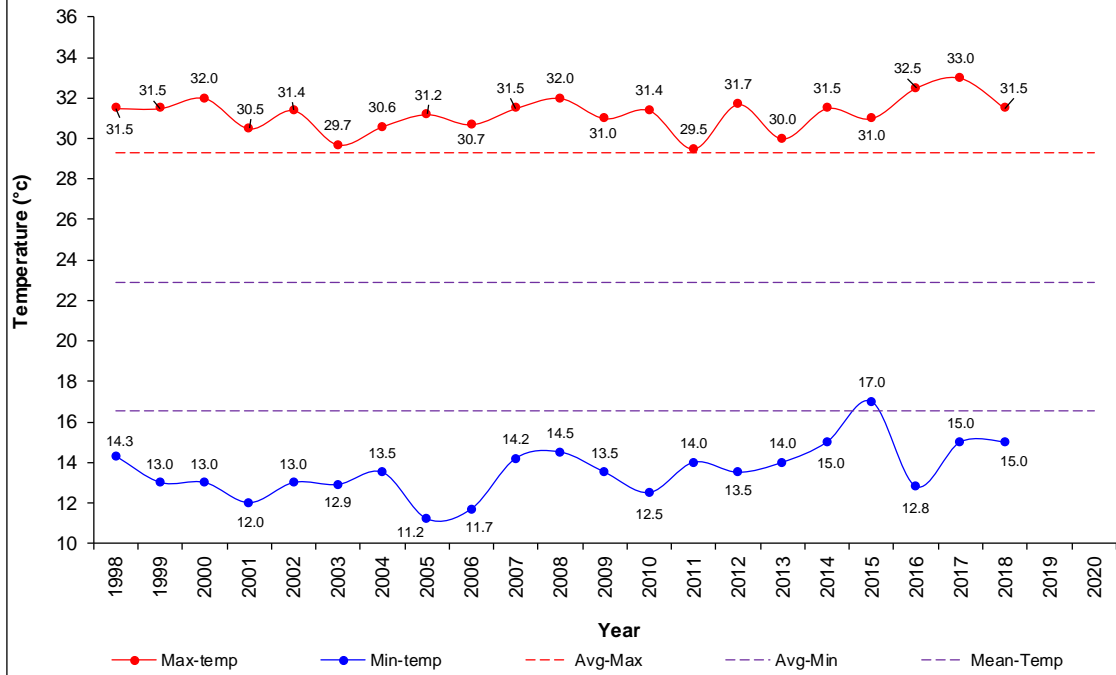




Extreme November Temperature at Dharan Bazar

Extreme Maximum Temperature ever recorded: 38.8°C on 12th April 2013

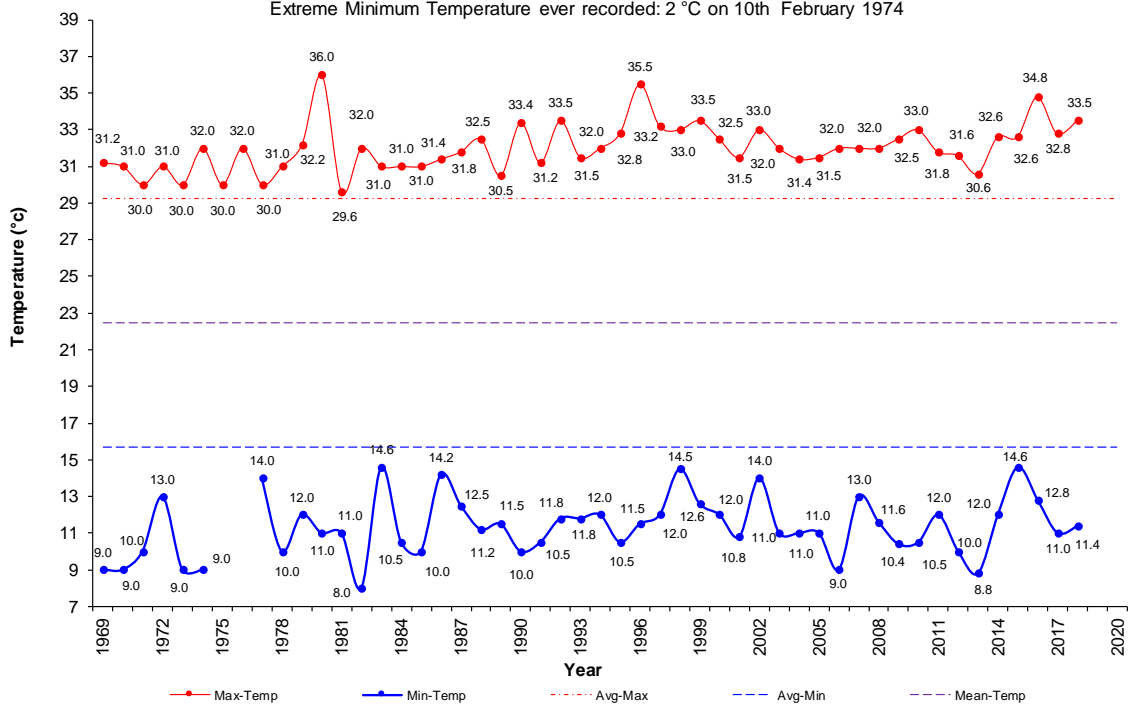
Extreme Minimum Temperature ever recorded: 4.1°C on 9th January 2013

Extreme Minimum Temperature ever recorded: 2°C on 10th February 1974



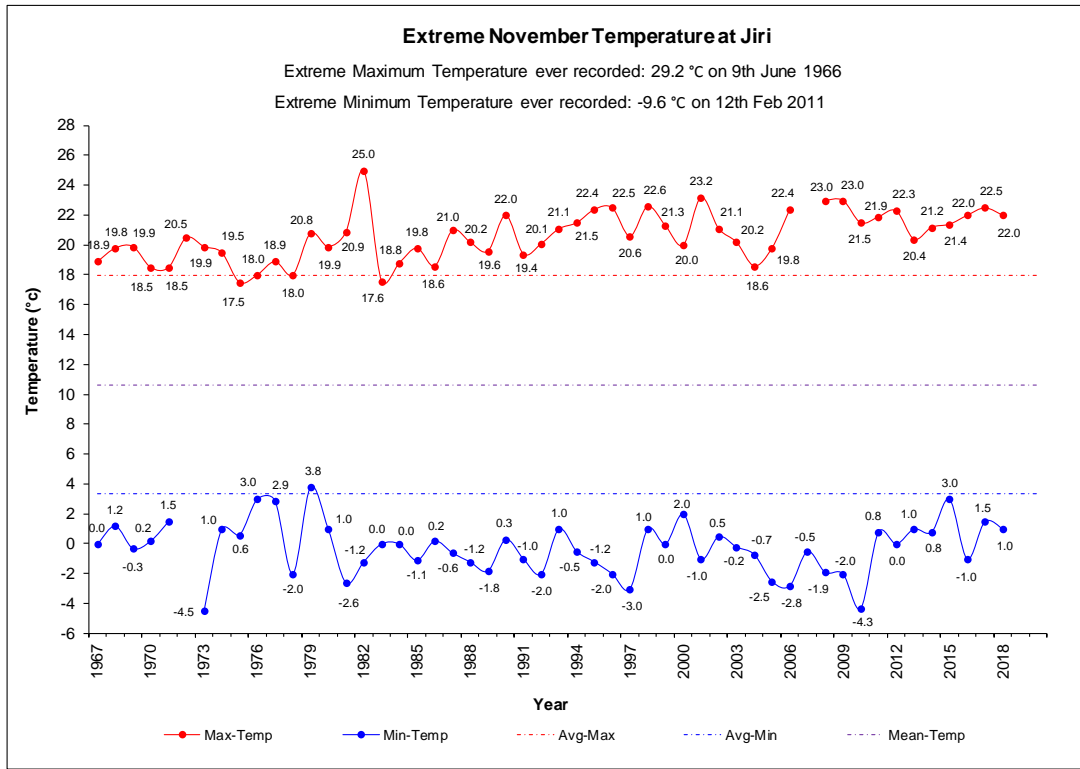

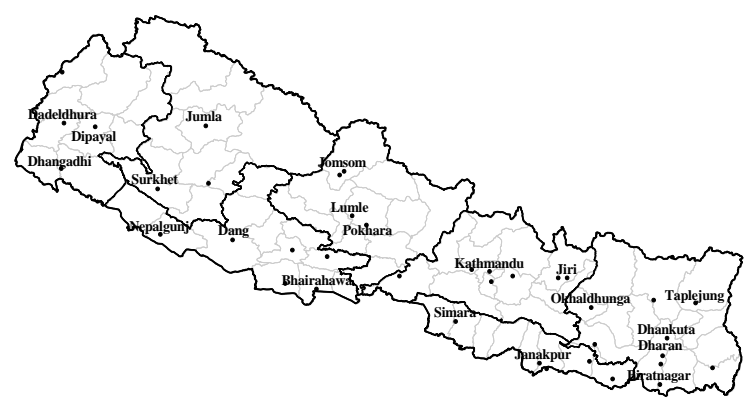


Fig: Map of Nepal showing the synoptic stations
