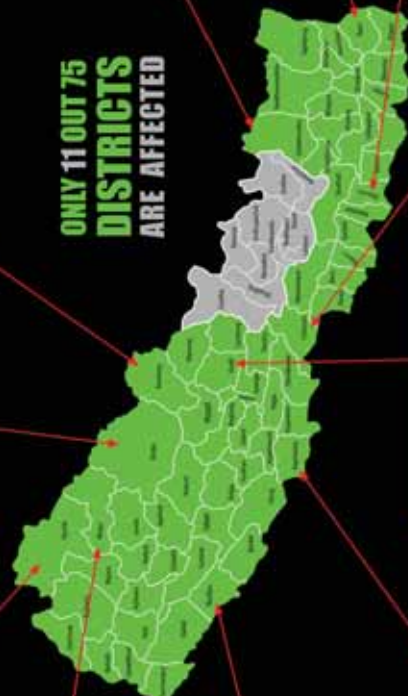

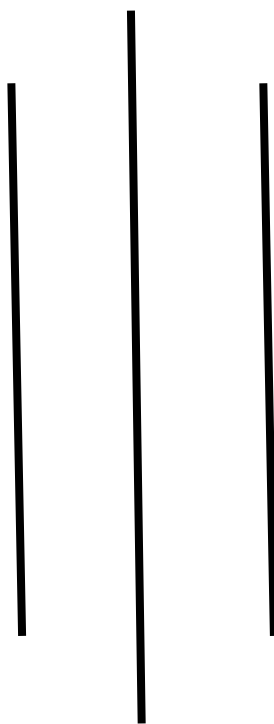

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Foreword

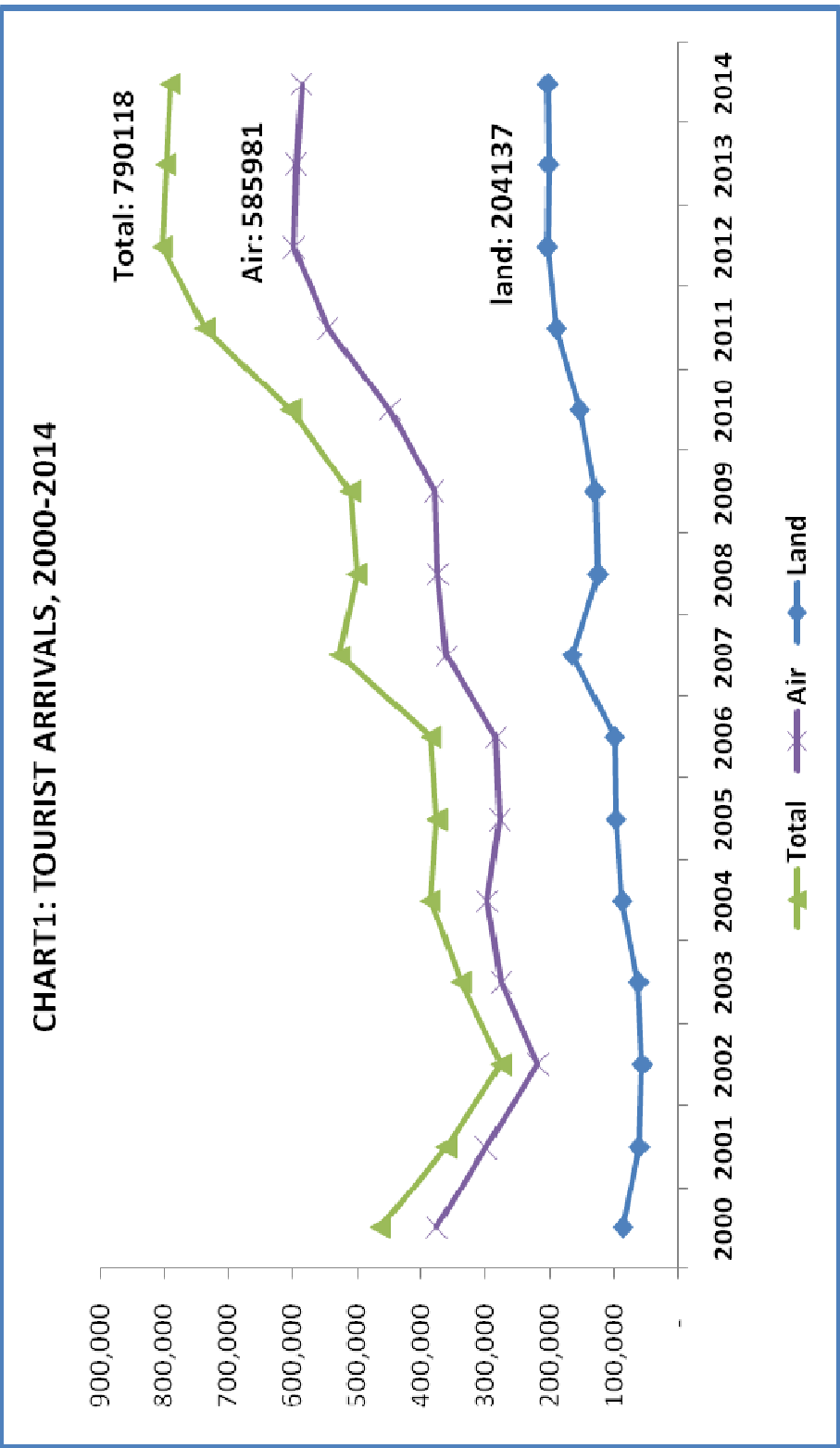

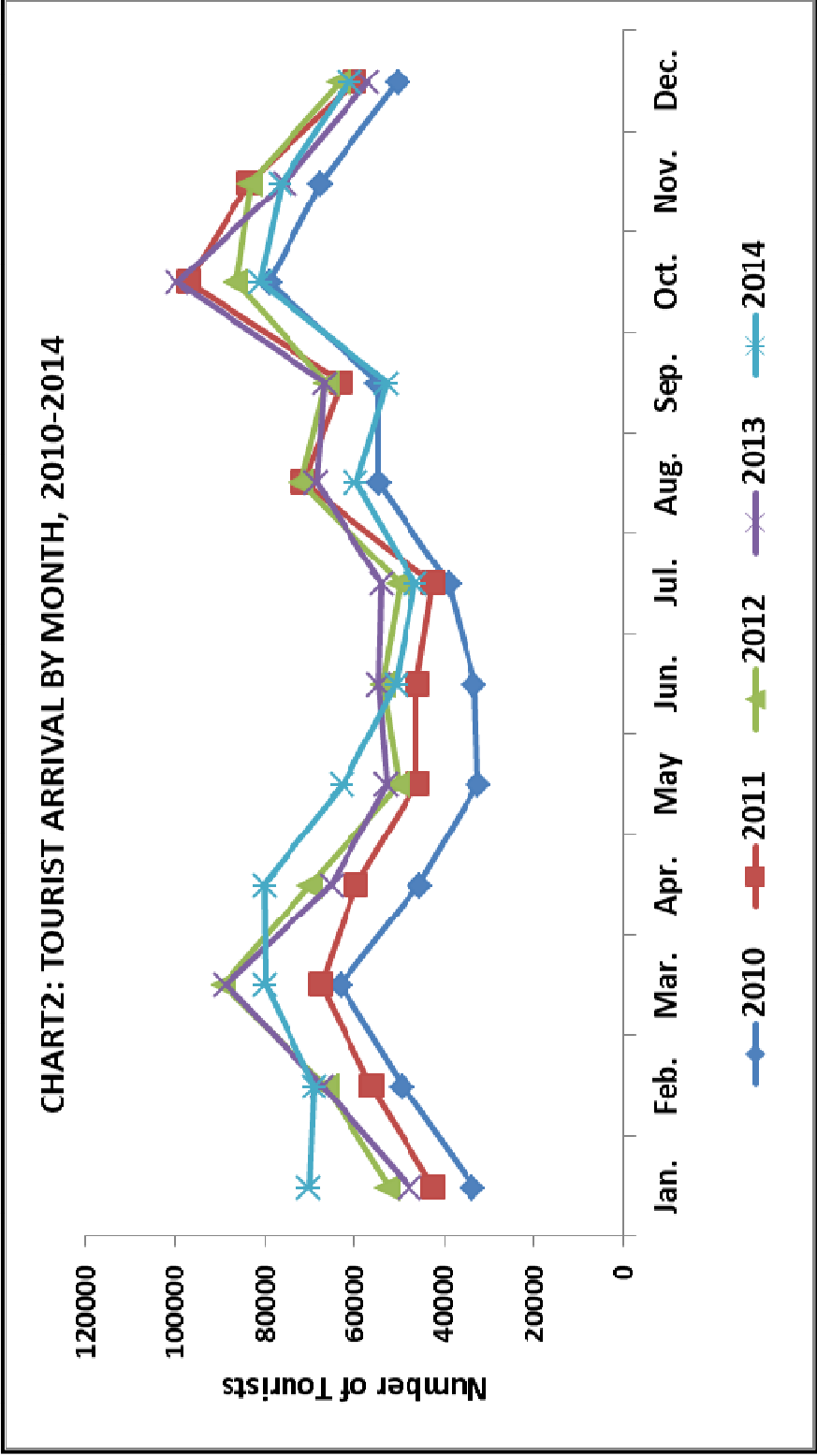

Chart3: Tourist Arrival By Year And Country, 1993-2014

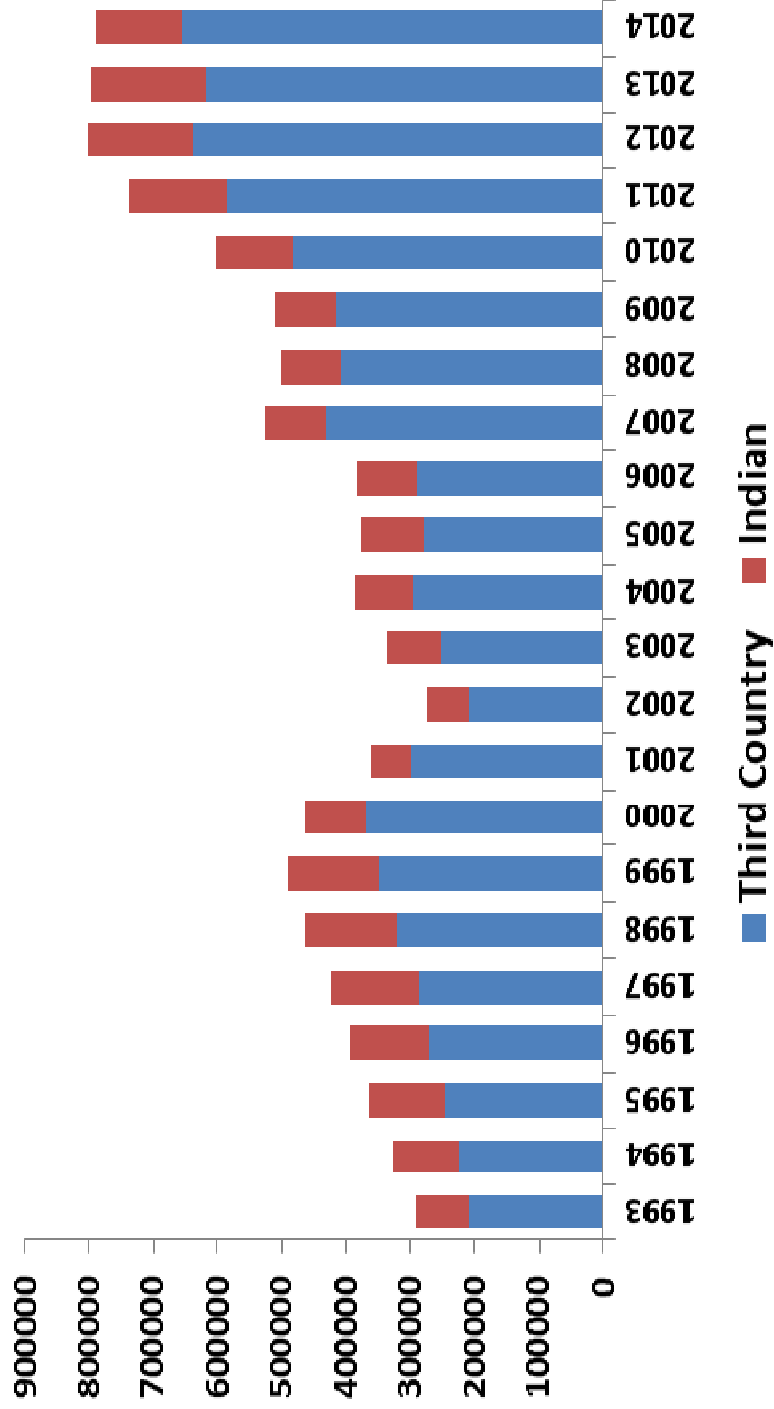

CHART4: TOURIST ARRIVAL BY SEX, 1993-2014

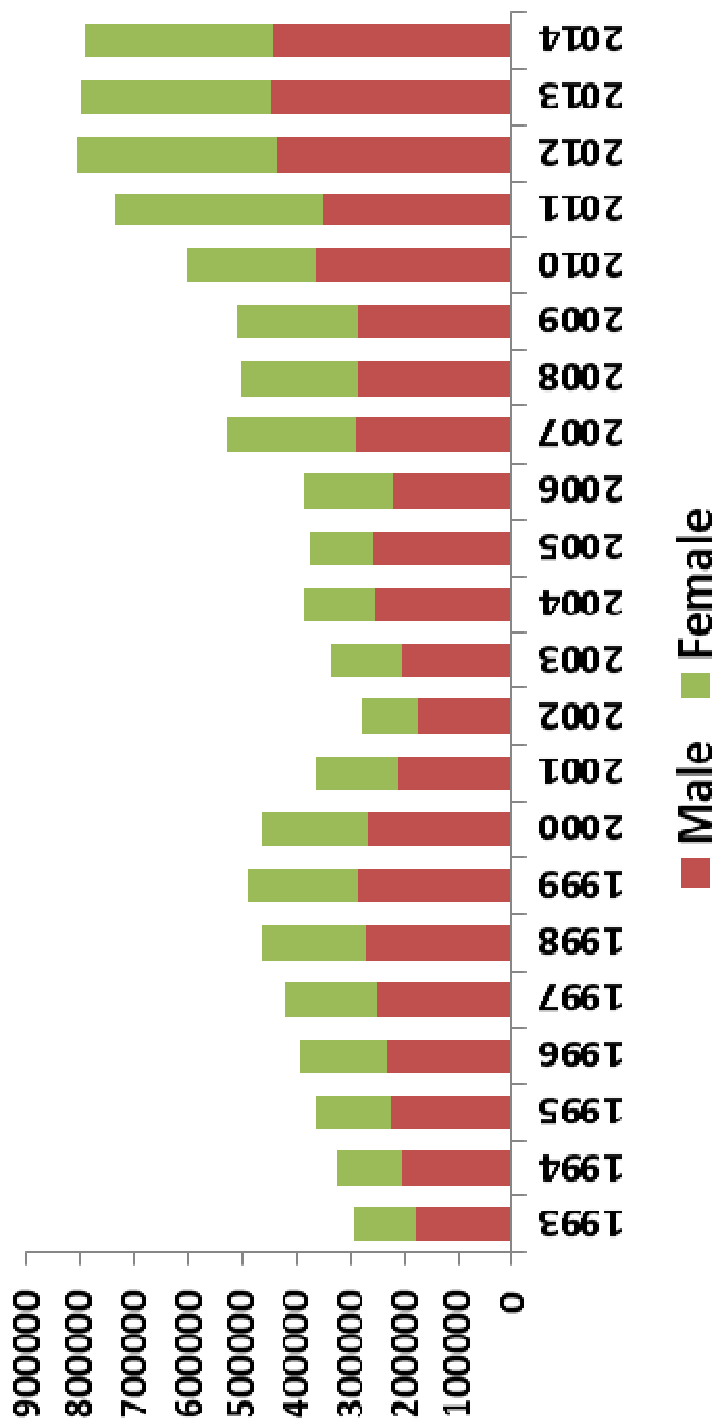

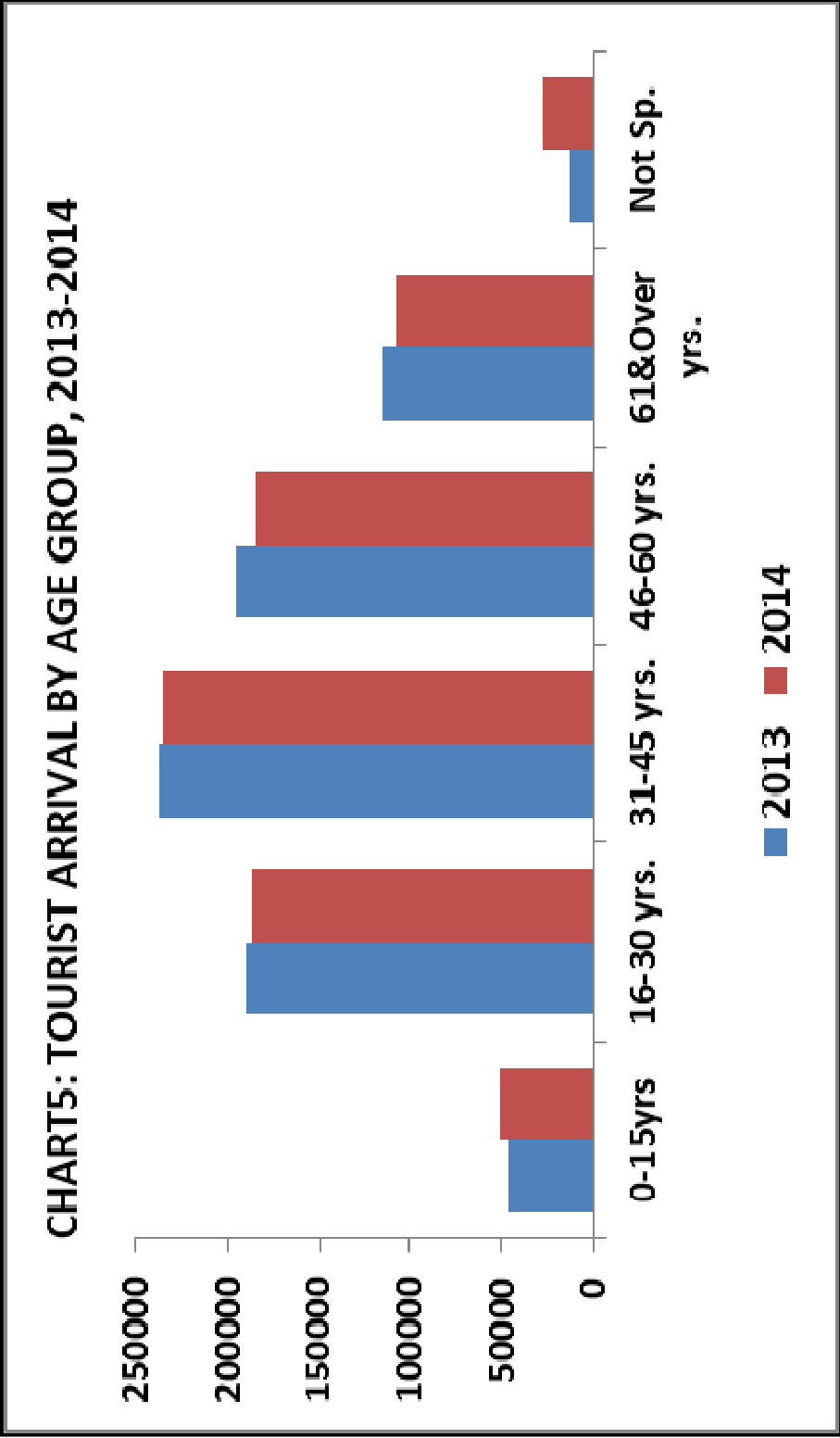

CHART 6: TOURIST ARRIVAL BY PURPOSE OF VISIT, 2014

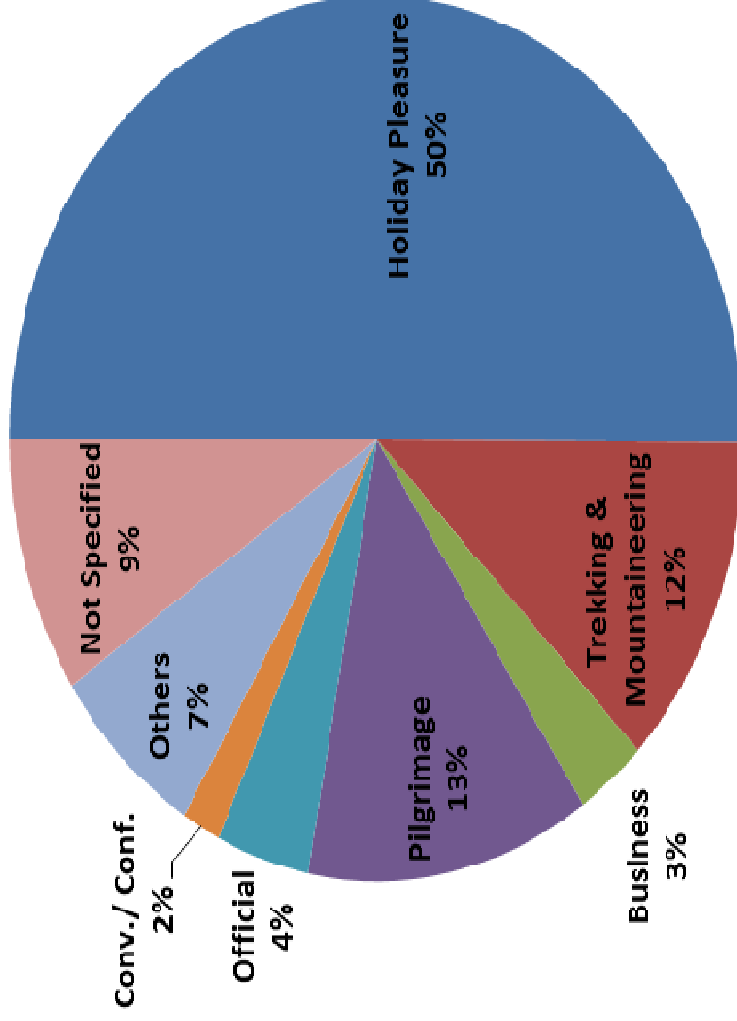

CHART 7: NUMBER OF TREKKERS IN DIFFERENT TREKKING AREAS, 2014

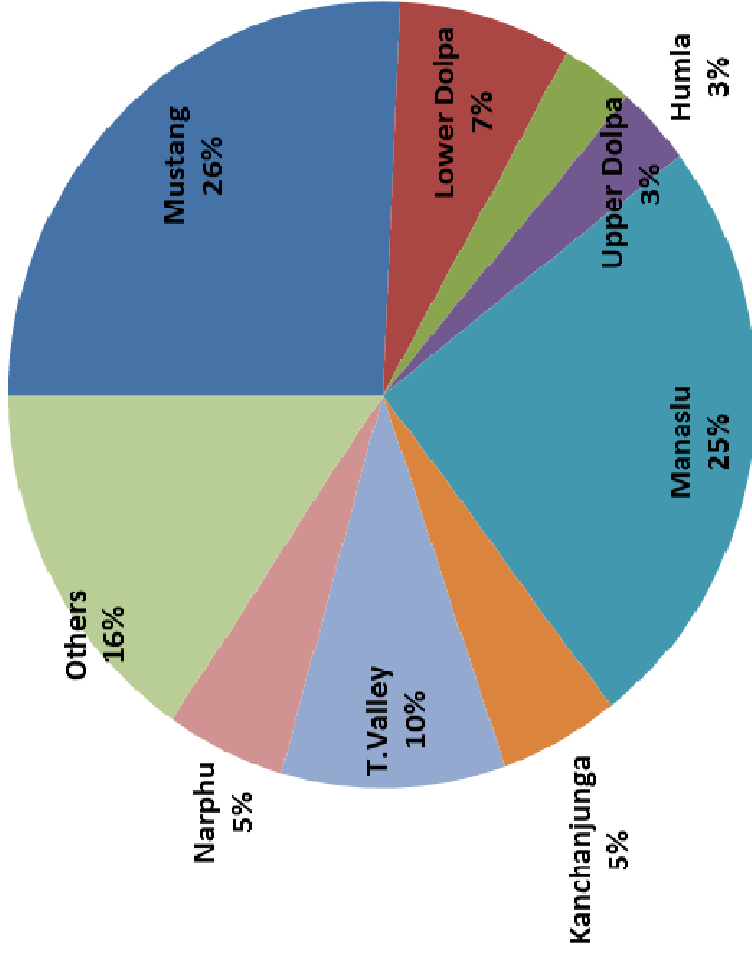

CHART8: NUMBER OF EXPEDITION MEMBERS BY PEAK, 2014

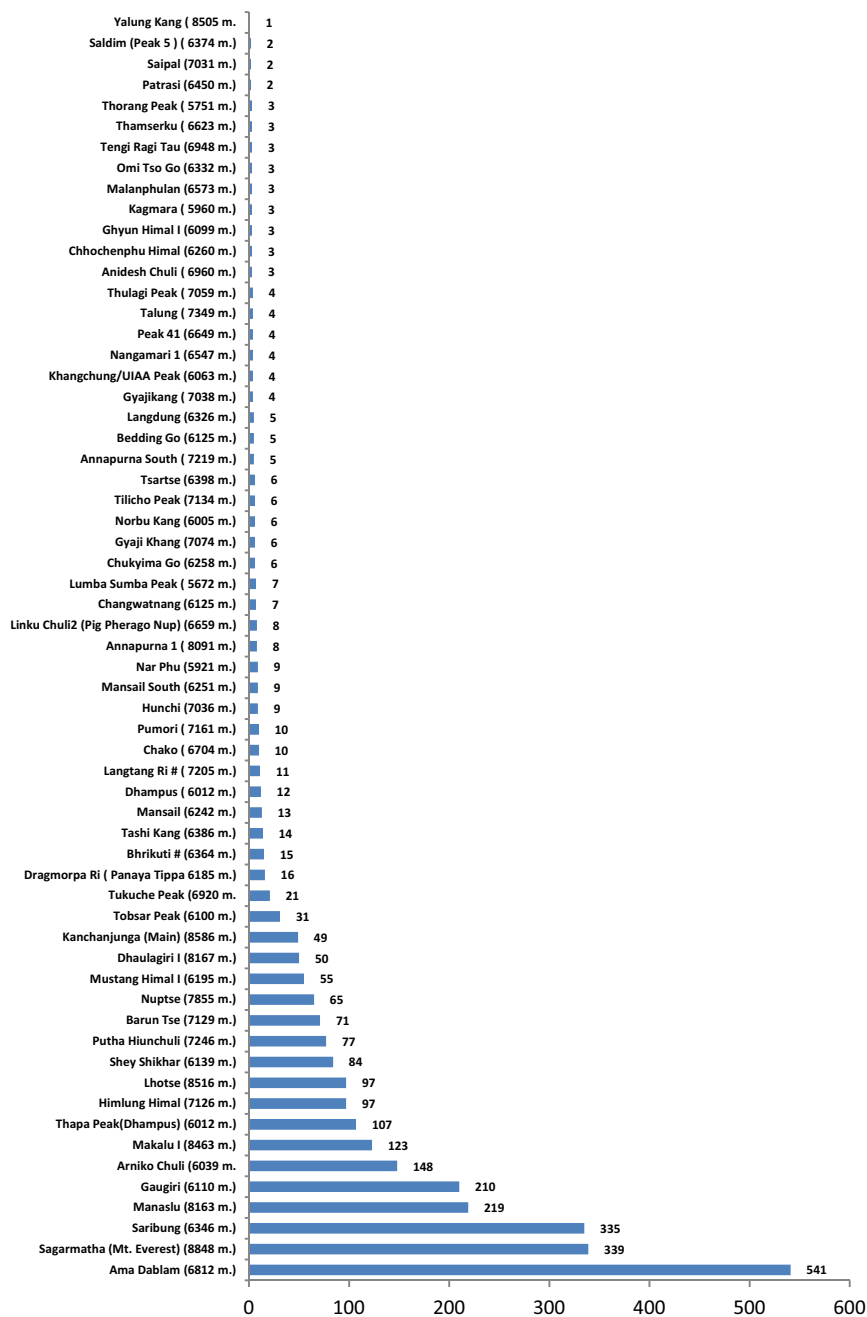


CHART9: NUMBER OF EXPEDITION SUMMITTERS BY PEAK, 2014

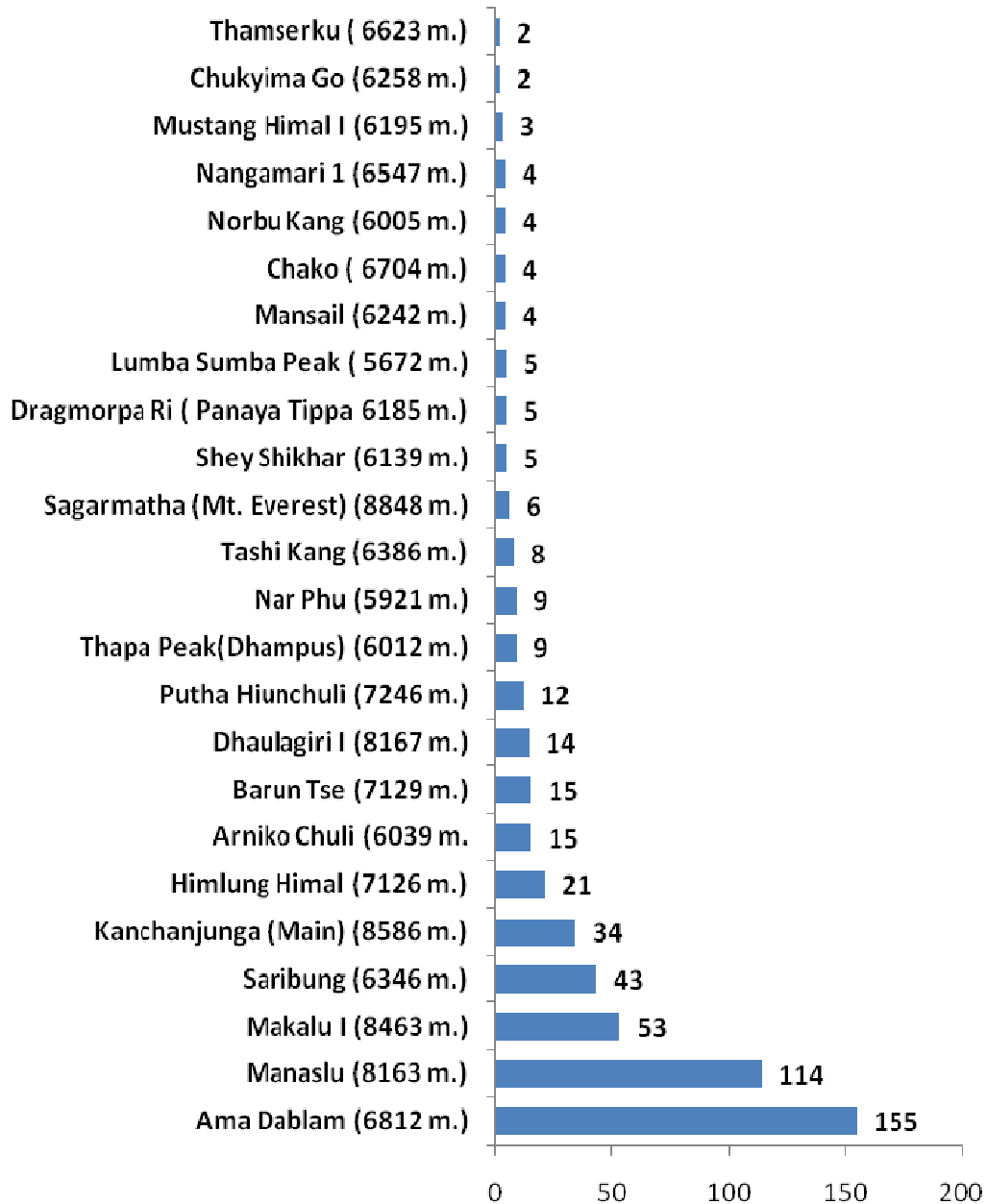

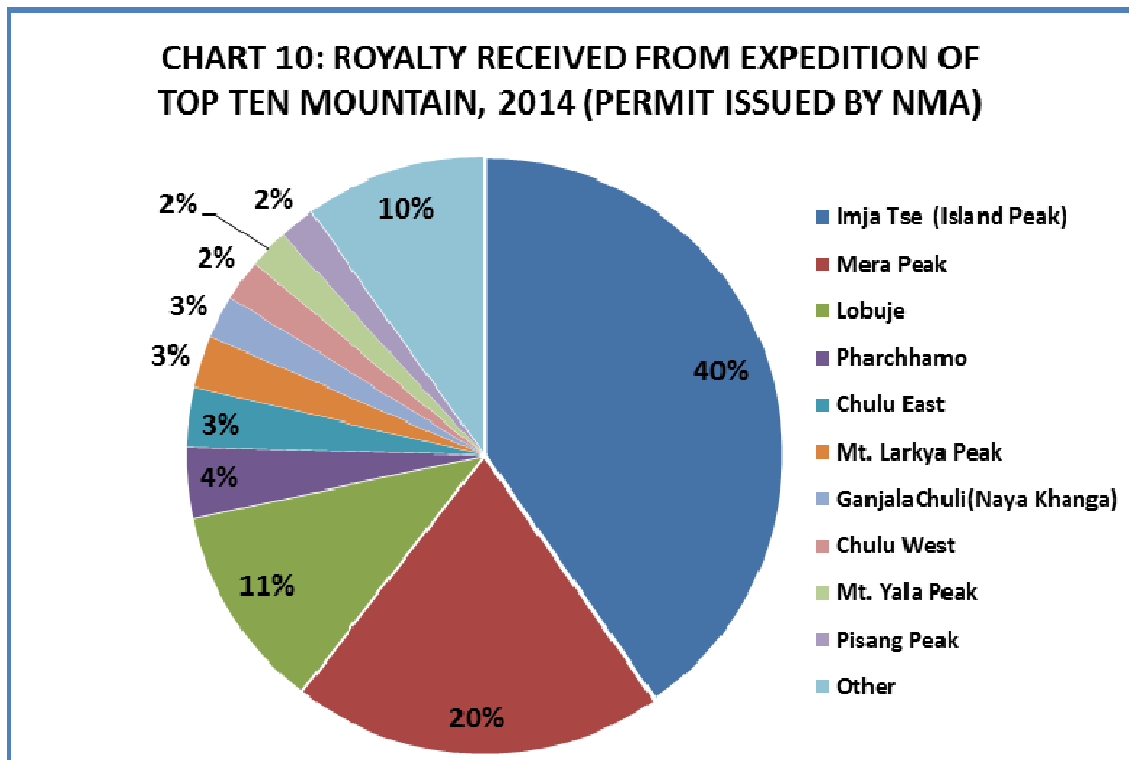

(PERMIT ISSUED BY NMA)**

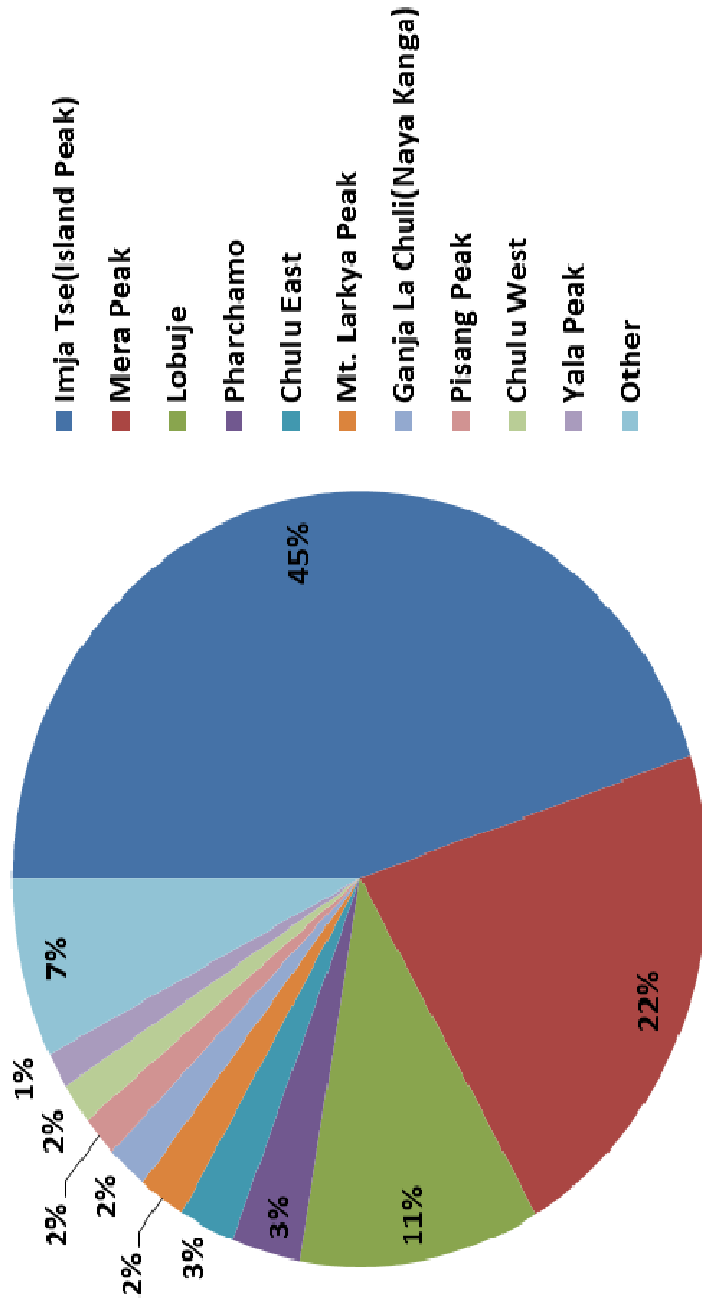

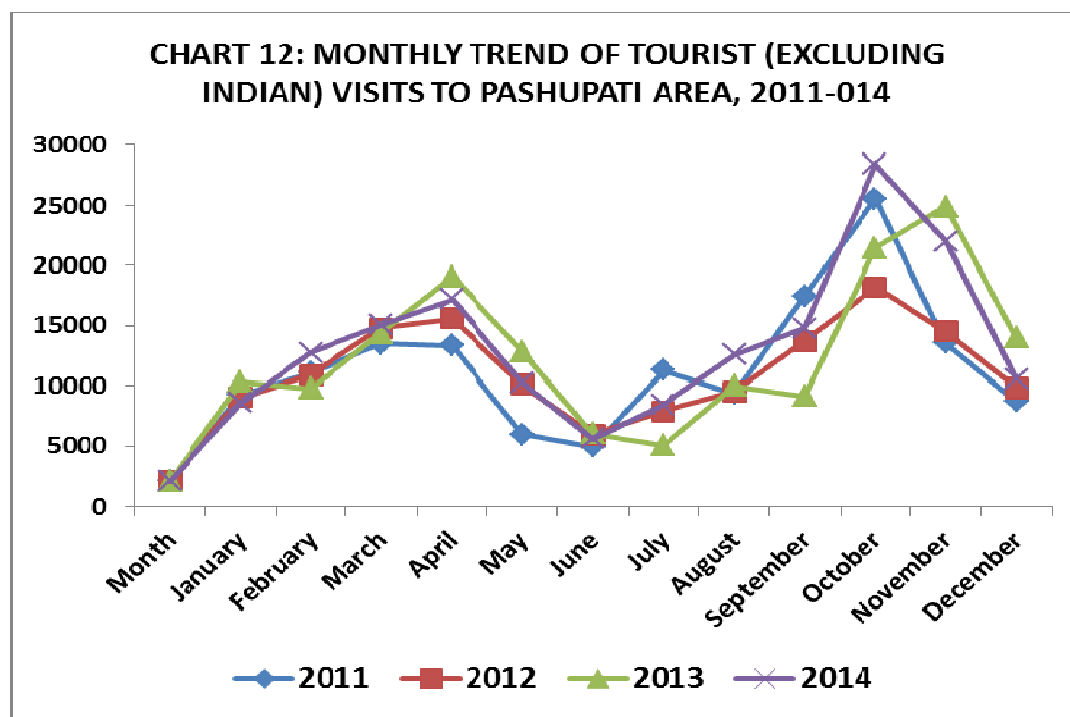

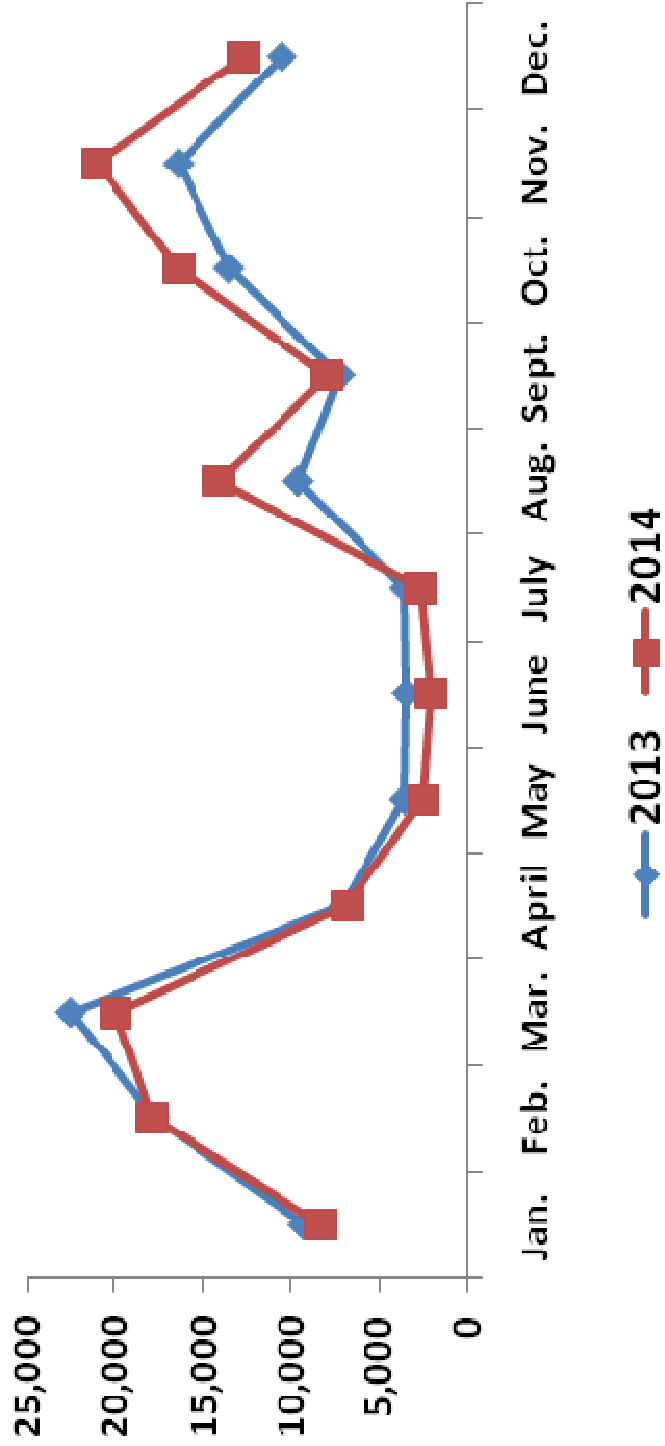

CHART 14: FOREIGN EXCHANGE EARNING FROM TOURISM BY FISCAL YEAR, 2058/59 TO 2070/71

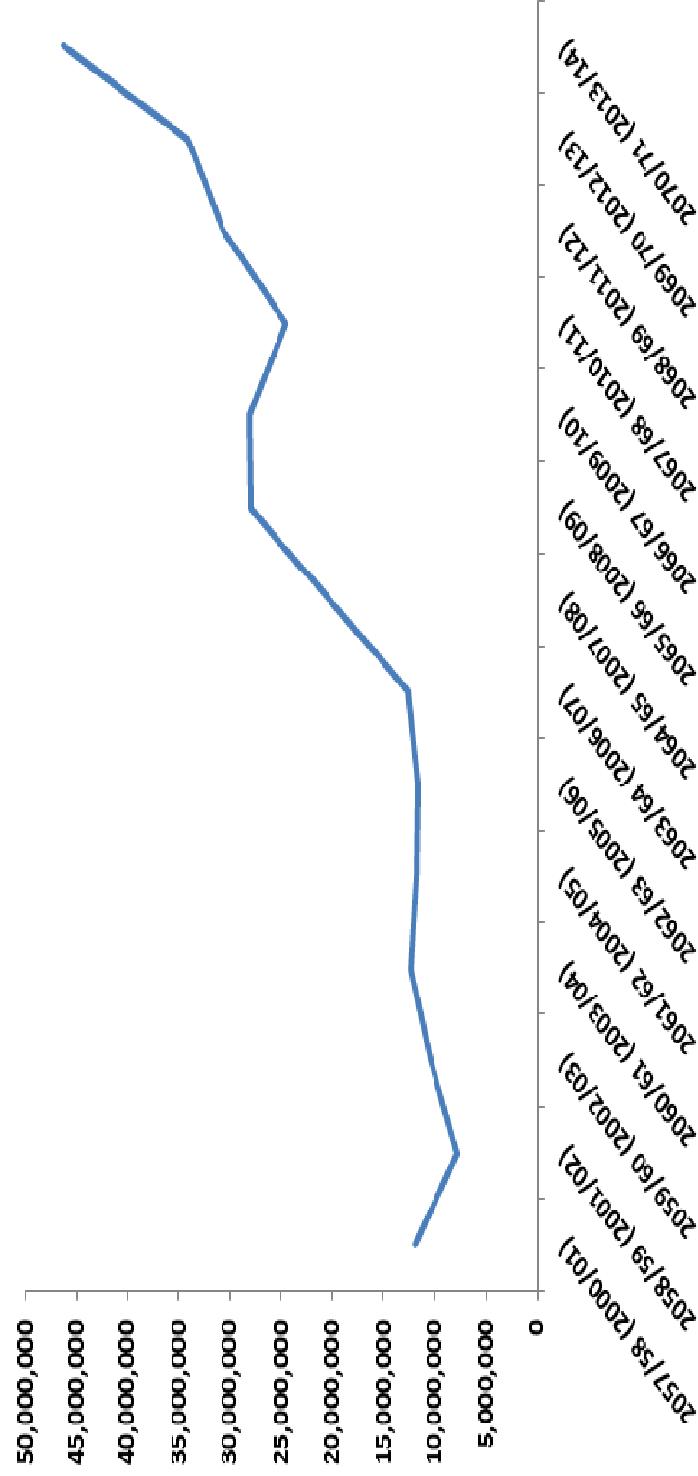

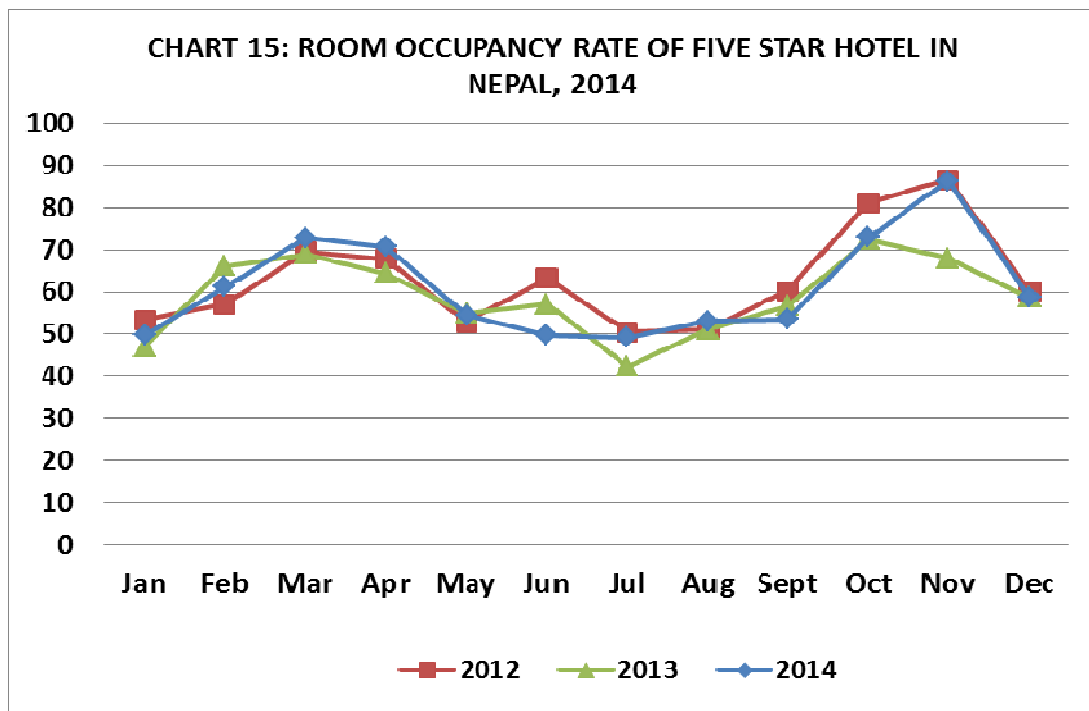
